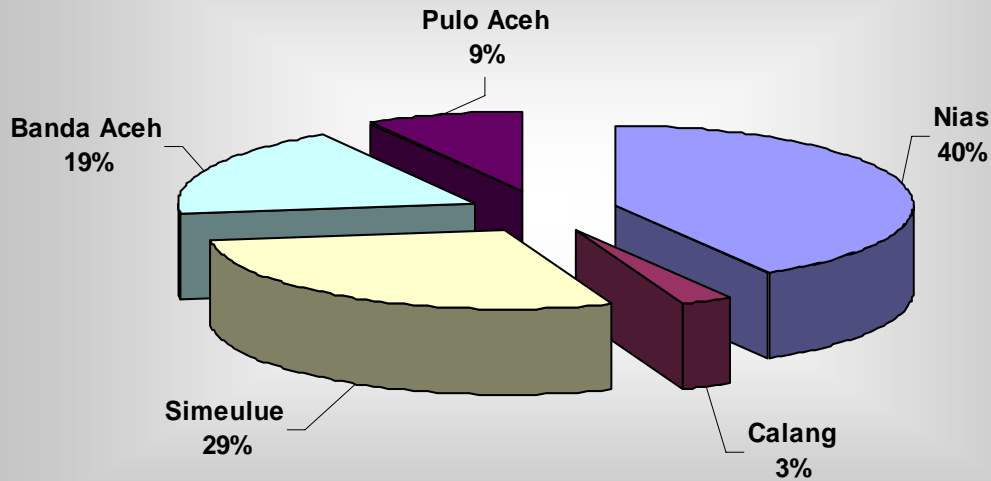
The trapped unit being released by another Manitou

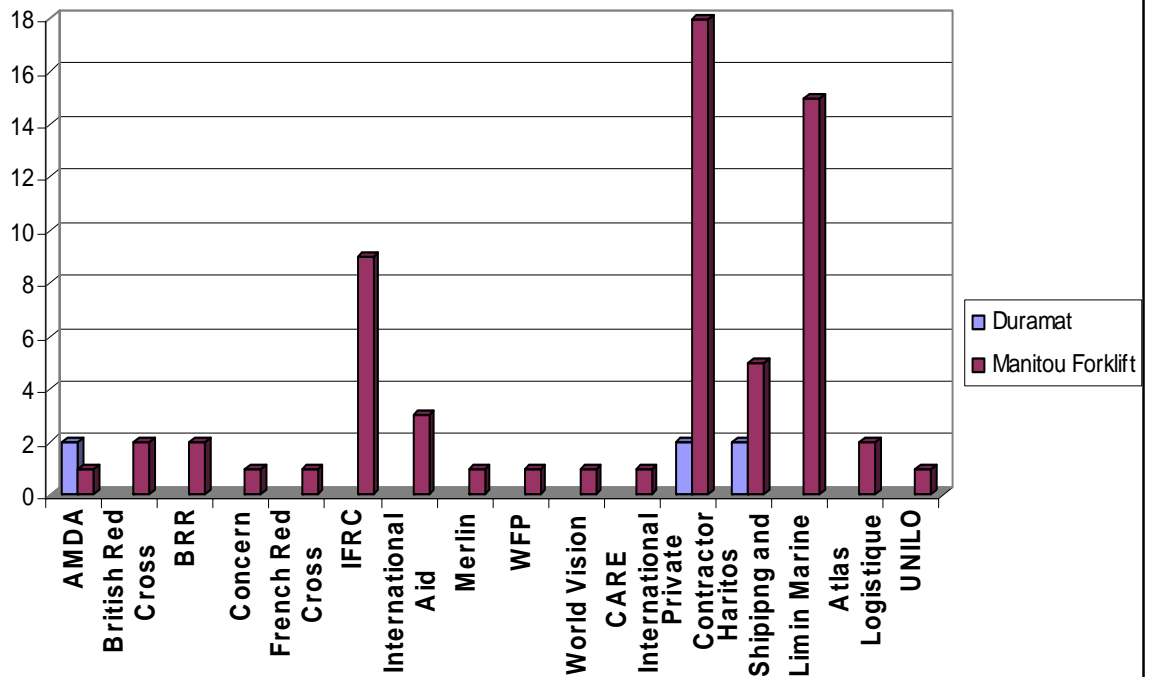

Completed Equipment Rental by Discharging Port



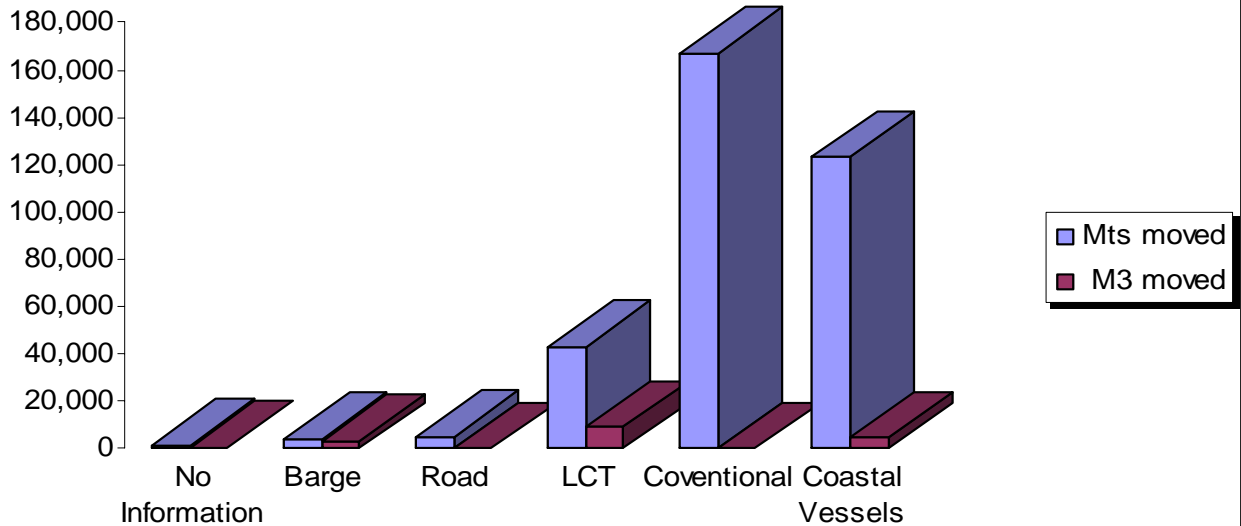
Rental Equipment Completed by Type of Equipment



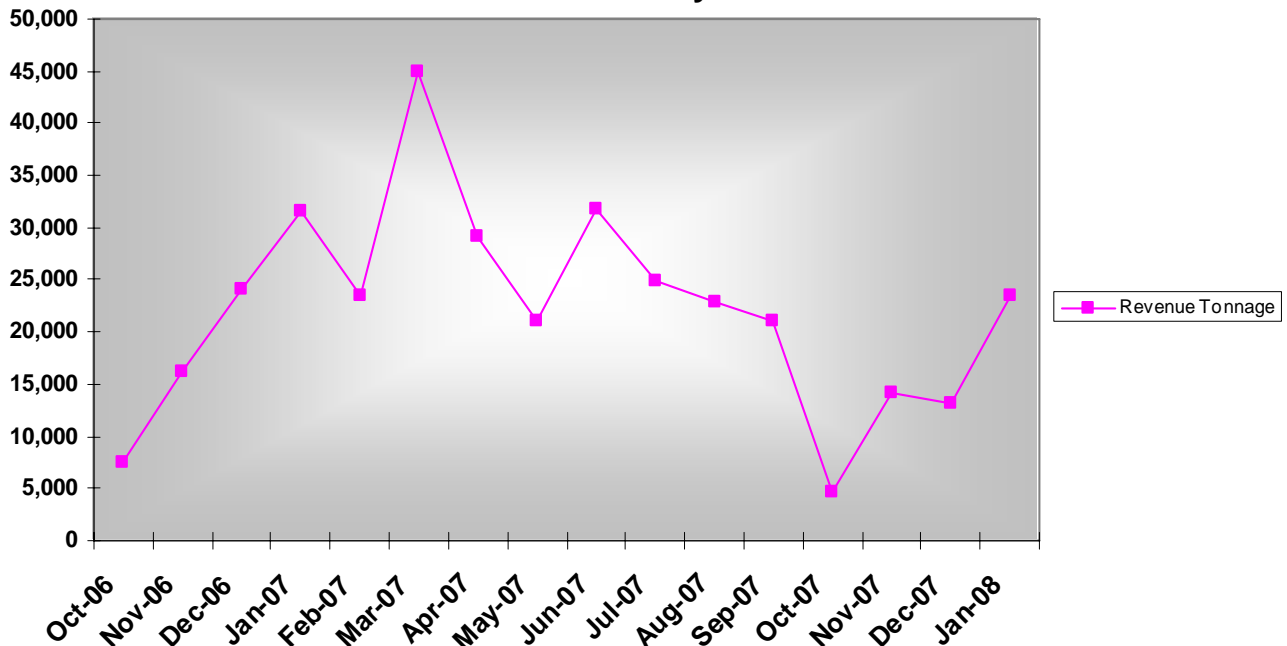
