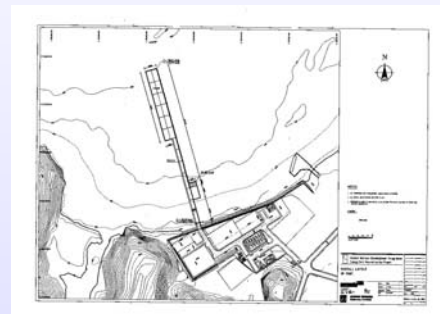


Cargo Handled at Cement Factory

Calang

Calang is in the process of constructing a new port, to be completed in approximately 18 months, with the following specifications: wharf length 150 m, width 25 m; depth from 5 m to 10 m, connected with trestle and RoRo ramp 15 m in length

and 5 m in width. The port is constructed for use by passengers and cargo. The port contains a passenger terminal, a fuel oil Depot with shore tank. Space has been allocated for possible future CPO shore tank and container yard.

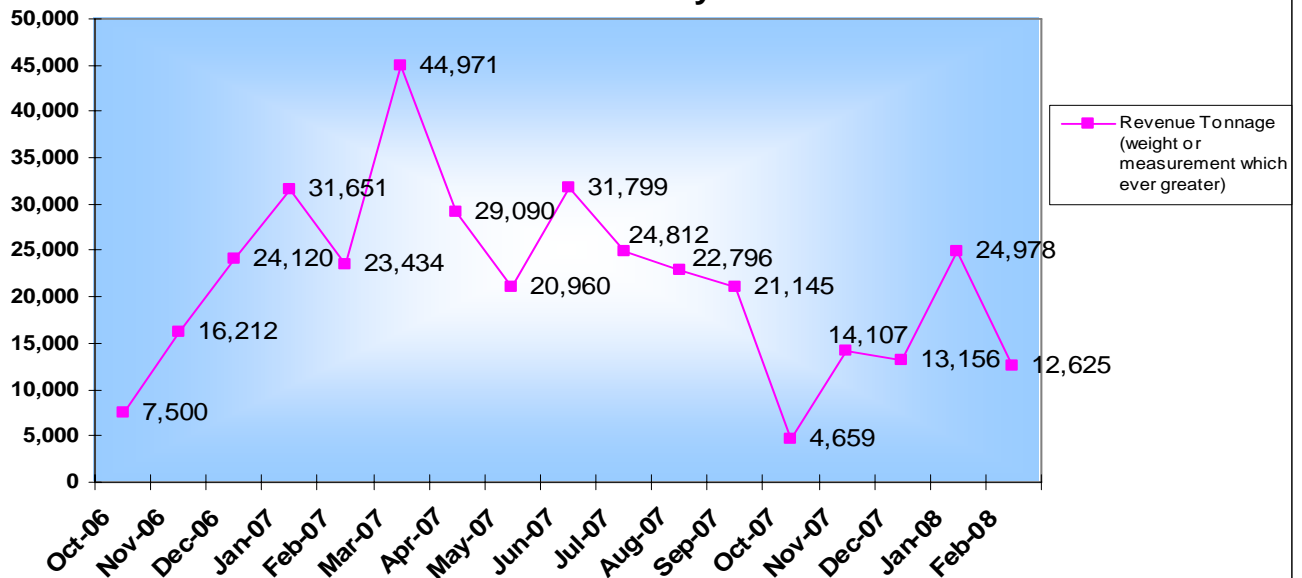
Versatile Manitou all terrain equipment handling Generators

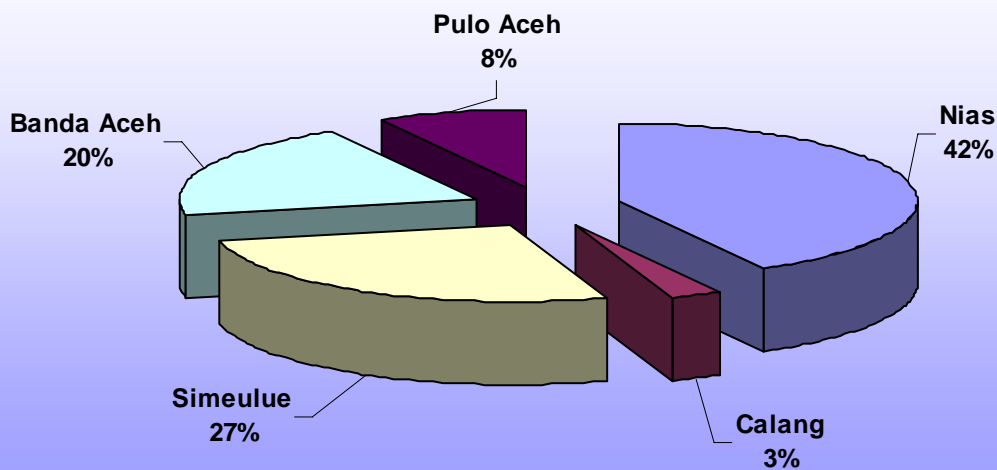
