OVERVIEW - CURRENT OPERATIONS

World Food Programme operations now focus on:

Logistics Support	Providing logistics support & consultancy to private sector and humanitarian organizations operating in the NAD-Nias area; Rental of cargo handling equipment
Training and ports institutional capability	Assessing & evaluating ports & institutional capability, procuring and arranging training for staff located at 15 Ports in NAD - Nias
Identification and quantification of cargo prospects	Providing 'latent' cargo demand forecasting & developing a database of existing and potential cargo, linking port gateways to the hinterland and livelihood projects.

The operation has established offices and equipment located in Nias (Gunung Sitoli) Simeulue (Sinabang) and Banda Aceh (Ulee Lhee & Lhoknga)

Banda Aceh

A Private Contractor (PT. Rimaco Express) rented one unit Manitou forklift to support discharging escalators from trucks for the newly constructed mall at Pasar Aceh.



Care International

One Manitou forklift was utilized by Care International Banda Aceh on 27th July 08, to assist moving one unit generator from their warehouse to their office.

Lhoknga (Aceh Besar)

1 unit Manitou forklift is being utilized by PT. Semen Andalas Indonesia for the cement factory in Lhoknga. PT. Semen Andalas Indonesia has extended their contract with WFP LSU to the end of December 08.

Malahayati

Shipping route Tanjung Priok – Malahayati is being established, first shipment scheduled 25th August 08, operated by PT. Bapamco Inti Perdana. They will utilize a container ship with capacity of 200 teus twice monthly. Pelindo 1 Malahayati has prepared a container reach stacker (KALMAR) and an open storage Container Depot of 12,000 m².

The KALMAR used was handed over from WFP LSU to BRR on 05th September 07. It was previously located in Belawan, and repositioned to Malahayati on 05th August 08.

The second KALMAR reach stacker was repositioned from Belawan to the Port of Lhokseumawe, 4th August 08 to be managed and operated by Pelindo 1, Lhokseumawe.

On July 24, the LCT 'AYU 68' arrived at Malahayati from Surabaya carrying 945 Cubic meters of construction materials for PT. Semen Andalas

Indonesia, Lafarge Lhoknga.

Simeulue

A Private Contractor (PT. Pama Makasar) with LCT Bina Satu has utilized one Manitou forklift to discharge construction material in Patriot, north - east Simeulue.

Nias

On 24 July 08, Totohi bridge in Tugala Lauru village east of Lahewa, Sub District Nias collapsed, due to an allegedly overloaded road vehicle passing the bridge. The truck subsequently toppled into the river, killing one person and injuring several people. The Manitou forklifts positioned in Gunung Sitoli were used to assist in loading the replacement parts transported to the bridge area.

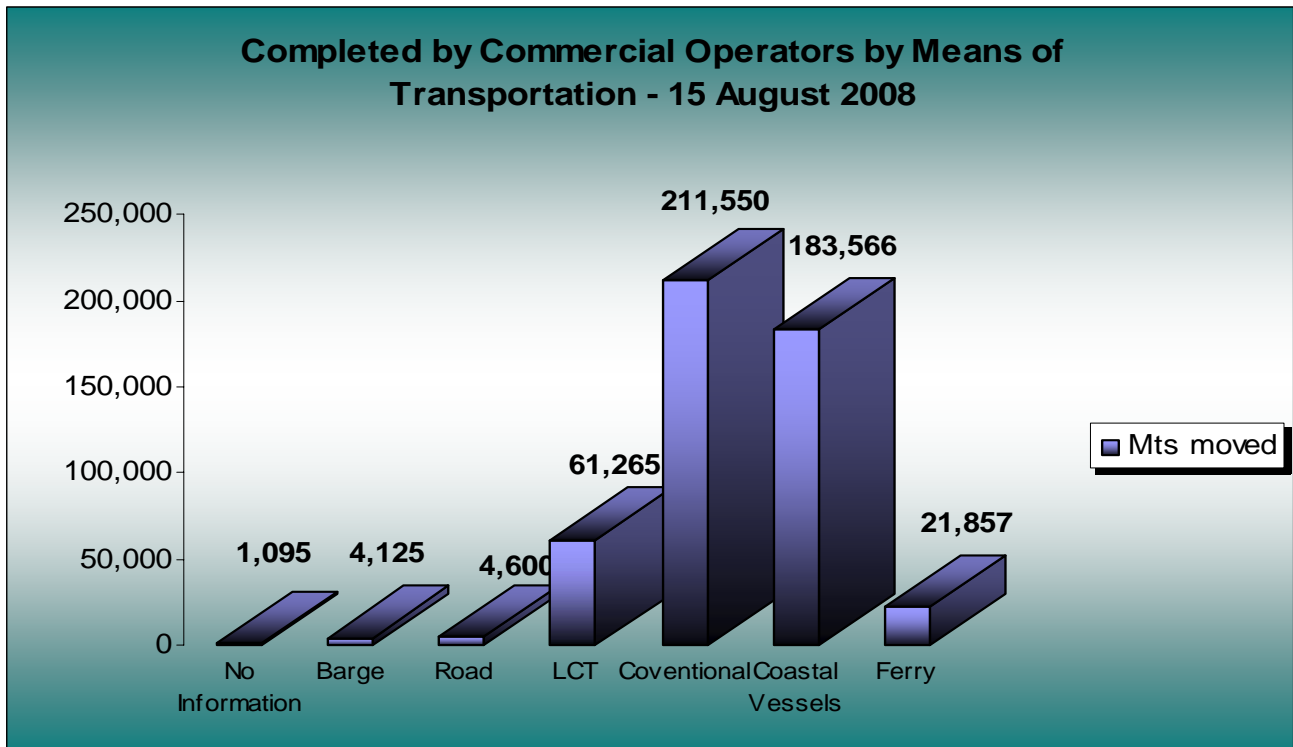
