Phase two of the operation, the focus is on the Logistics support service (LSU) incorporating cargo handling equipment, Port capacity development and latent cargo forecasting. ### OVERVIEW - CURRENT OPERATIONS

World Food Programme operations now focus on:

Logistics Support	Providing logistics support & consultancy to private sector and humanitarian organizations operating in the NAD-Nias area; Rental of cargo handling equipment
Training and ports institutional capability	Assessing & evaluating ports & institutional capability, procuring and arranging training for staff located at 15 Ports in NAD - Nias
Identification and quantification of cargo prospects	Providing 'latent' cargo demand forecasting & developing a database of existing and potential cargo, linking port gateways to the hinterland and livelihood projects.

The operation has established offices and equipment located in Nias (Gunung Sitoli) Simeulue (Sinabang) and Banda Aceh (Ulee Lhee & Lhoknga)

#### NAD-Nias Port Training

WFP LSU have distributed letters to 15 ports in NAD and Nias in order to obtain information on participants to the Port Training, estimated to commence in end-October 2008. Letters have been sent to Harbour Masters, Port Administrators and Managers, Pelindo I, and to ASDP (Ferry Corporation).

#### Center for Tsunami Research and Mitigation of National Disasters in NAD Province



A new Tsunami research and mitigation center was completed in July 2008 in Ulee Lheue. The center is built to alleviate the risks associated with a Tsunami and other natural disasters. Through an early warning system, the center also functions as a safe haven in the event of a Tsunami, as

well as a training center for disaster mitigation.

#### Malahayati

PT. Bapamco Inti Perdana as operator of the container service Jakarta – Malahayati is rescheduling the first voyage. According to information received from the Pelindo I Malahayati Port Manager, the first voyage will commence after Hari Raya on 03 October 2008. The arrival containers will be discharged by ship crane onto the trailer on the wharf. This will be done on a CY to CY (Container Yard) basis. The stripping of the container will be done inside the Malahayati Port open storage. Initially it will be 150 teu / trip / month. The service will be open to all traders with box rates to IDR. 10,000,000 per teu CY CY Jakarta – Malahayati.

#### Lhoknga (Aceh Besar)

One Manitou forklift unit is currently utilized by PT. Semen Andalas Indonesia for the cement factory in Lhoknga. PT. Semen Andalas Indonesia has extended their contract with WFP LSU to the end of

December 08. An additional Manitou forklift unit was requested by the contractor from 4 October until 3 November 2008.

#### Simeulue

A Private Contractor (PT. Adhi Karya) continues to utilize a WFP LSU Manitou forklift for the Sinabang port development project.

#### Nias

As of Friday, 5 September 2008, persistent torrential rains over the last 2 weeks have caused two sub-districts in Nias to be inundated with water. The affected sub-districts are Kecamatan Gido and Bawolato. The floodwater has overflowed from the river Mola and has covered 5 villages with water, 50cm to 2m deep. The villages in question are Siofaewali and Sohya (in Bawolato sub-district) and Hiliweto Gido, Hilisebua and Hilibadalu (in Gido sub-district)

#### Shortage of Cement in Nias Island

There is currently a shortage of cement in Nias Island due to port congestion in Teluk Bayur

port, with Padang as loading port for cement.

This is expected to impact

ongoing projects on the Island.

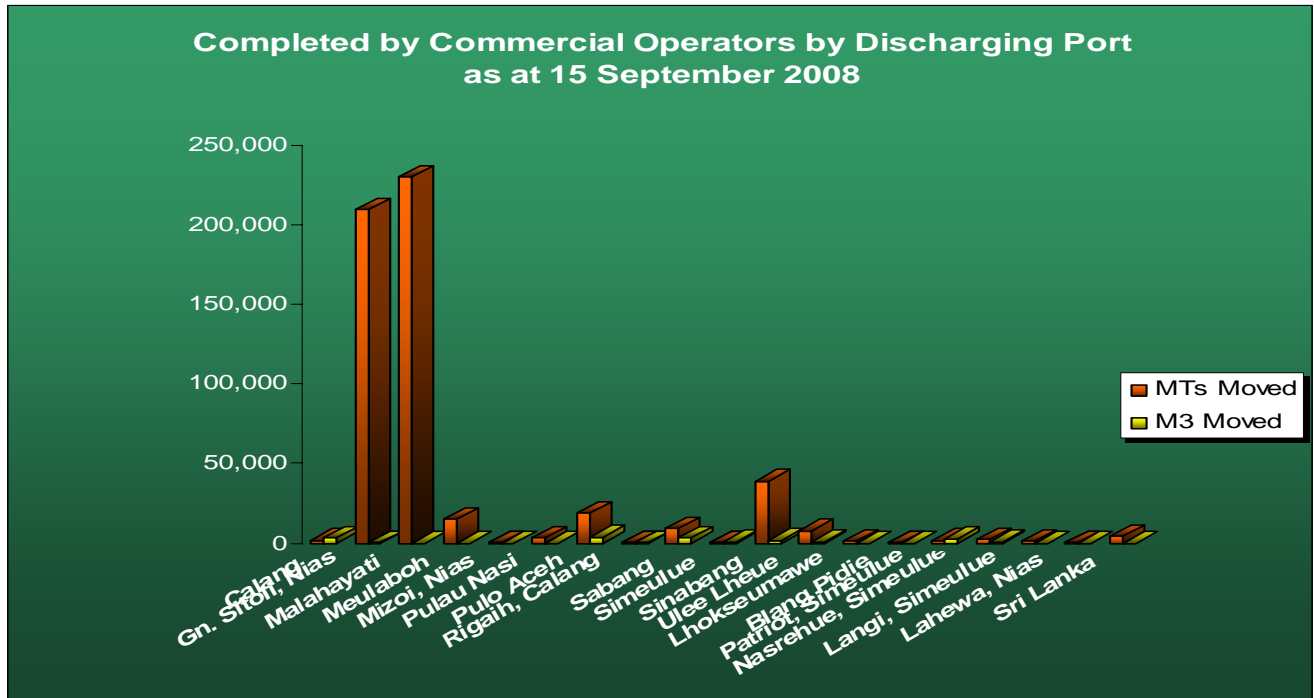

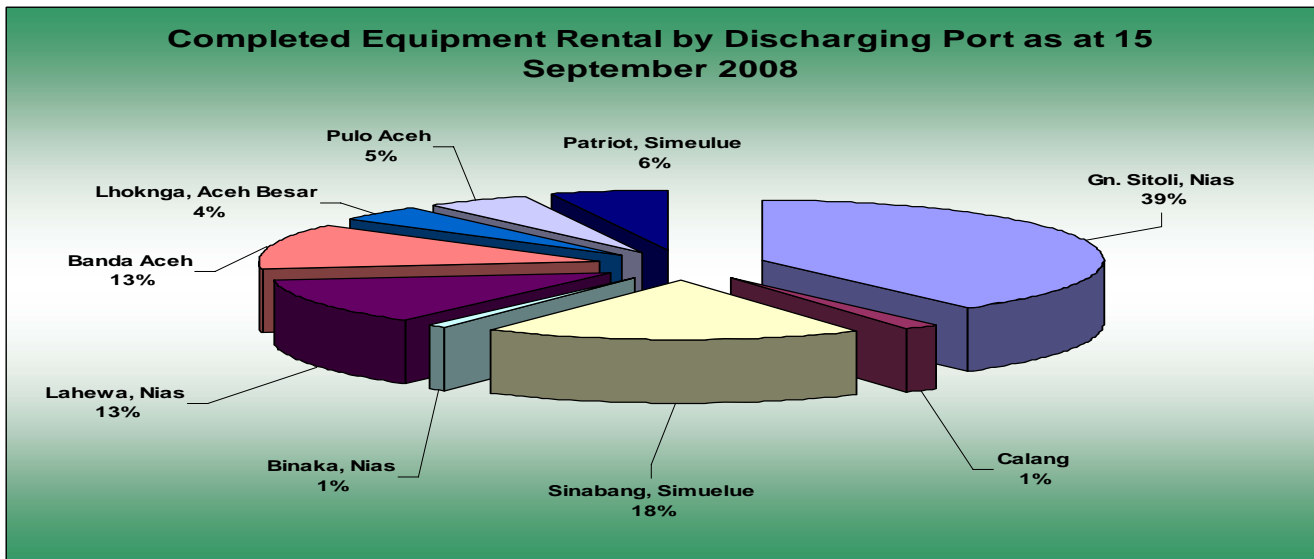
