### Capacity Development Training

During the reporting period, 168 participants from 18 ports were trained in 12 different modules in order to allow all participants to have an overview of the project activities in NAD – Nias. Certificates were handed out by members of various United Nations Agencies present in NAD – Nias.

At the end of each class, the participants are requested to complete an **“evaluation / feedback” form**. Preliminary feedback shows that students are pleased with the training and sought a continuation of the training for themselves and other members of their respective port organizations.
