Capacity Development Training

In phase two of the training WFP LSU invited a total of 75 participants to attend three classes. Each class will accommodate maximum 25 participants from 18 ports in Aceh and Nias as well as staff from the Governor office, Dinas Perhubungan and BPKS Sabang (Management Board of Sabang Free Port and Free Trade Zone). In addition, two observers from the University of Syiah Kuala will attend.

The first course of Phase two of the specialized Port Capacity Development training, "Containerization and International Best Practices" was scheduled to start on the 22nd of March 2010 and to be completed by end of 27 March 2010. However, further to temporary restrictions on travel put in place prior to the commencement of the course, the course was re-scheduled for a later date.

The training is now scheduled to commence with the "Monitoring and Evaluation" course on the 12th of April 2010 and end on 17 April 2010 with the venue either in Banda Aceh or in Medan. The second class will be "Operations and Maintenance" on 26 April 2010 to 01 May 2010.

The "Containerization and International Best Practices" has been re-scheduled for 31 May 2010 to 5 June 2010.
