Capacity Development Training

Module 1 of the training commenced with a “Monitoring and Evaluation” course, from 12th – 17th April 2010. The training took place in Hotel Madani Medan, and was attended by 23 participants from 18 ports Aceh – Nias and Government office. Invitations were sent to 25 participants and two observers from University of Syiah Kuala.

Since the travel restriction in Aceh province was lifted on the 16th of April 2010, Module 2, “Operations and Maintenance” was held in Banda Aceh, commenced on the 26th of April 2010 and ended on 1st May 2010. WFP LSU invited 25 participants from 18 ports in Aceh and Nias as well as staff from Dinas Perhubungan and BPKS Sabang (Management Board of Sabang Free Port and Free Trade Zone).

The training phase two will end on the 5th of June 2010 with the “Containerization and International Best Practices” class. All close out training phase two formalities will be concluded by the end of June 2010 in terms of the agreement.

Previously, phase one of the port training ended on 17 December 2009. All materials will be handed over to a selected teaching / training organization. University of Syiah Kuala is one of the selected organizations to receive the training course materials. The hand over of the training course materials is still under process.
