Capacity Development Training

In July, 232 participants from 18 ports were trained in 22 different modules in order to allow all participants to have an overview and understand the overall managements of Ports in NAD – Nias. Certificates are handed out at the end of each course by members of various United Nations Agencies / MDF present in NAD – Nias, who give a brief overview of their project.

WFP LSU to date arranged 76 course modules run from 16th December 09 until 31 July 09 with 1193 total participants, there are 43 courses modules remain, through to the end of training on the 11th December 2009

On 27 July 2009, WFP LSU and STET Maritime Singapore conducted the 2nd quarterly meeting at STET Maritime Singapore offices to update and review past months activities, the first quarterly meeting has conducted at WFP LSU office.

There will be no training activities from 24th August through 25th September 2009.

At the end of each class, the participants are requested to complete an **“evaluation / feedback” form**. Preliminary feedback shows that students are pleased with the training and sought a continuation of the training for themselves and other members of their respective port organizations.
