

Funded by the Multi Donor Fund for Aceh and Nias (MDF), World Food Programme Shipping Service, a module of the WFP Global Logistics organization, established in October 2005, offering the overall total logistics support services to the Humanitarian reconstruction initiatives in Aceh and Nias. Phase two of the operation, the focus is on the Logistics support service (LSU) incorporating cargo handling equipment, Port capacity development and latent cargo forecasting. www.wfplsu.org

Capacity Development Training

In December, 81 participants from 18 ports attended 06 courses. The courses included training in English, Cargo Movement and Hazardous Cargo with the venue in UN Compound. Certificates are handed out at the end of each course by representatives of various United Nations Agencies / MDF-linked projects present in NAD – Nias, who provide a brief overview of their project activities that has links to efficient port gateways.

Phase one of the training ended on the 17th of December 2009, in the period from the 16th December 2008, WFP LSU arranged 133 course / training modules with 1,943 participants benefiting from the training within 528 training days. To conclude the Port Training WFP LSU will conduct "Field Trip" for Port Capacity Development to visit Belawan Port during 11 – 14 January 2010 with 36 participants selected from 18 ports in NAD - Nias.

At the end of each class, the participants are requested to complete an "evaluation / feedback" form. The preliminary feedback illustrate that students are satisfied with the training and enquired if continuation of the training is planned for the future. The training is scheduled to continue through the University of Syiah Kuala.
