Sibolga - Nias Pre-Booked RO/RO Service

Since cargo/trucks can be booked with effect from Friday 18 August on a cost-recovery basis at the request of BRR, WFPSS now received the first booking from Caritas Austria to move 8 trucks of building materials. However, there are still no requests received from BRR for this route.

Kalma Training in Belawan

Four operators and one logistics officer undertook a 3-day Kalmar Operator &



Maintenance training from 12 to 14 September in Belawan. The two Kalmars will be placed under storage at Samudera Group Containers Compound till agreement for rent of the Kalmars with port authorities and Samudera can be reached, or the equipment can be handed over to BRR. Operator maintenance checks are mandatory to be carried on a daily & weekly frequency so as to maintain these Kalmars at operational level.

UNDP Jetty in Calang

Construction of UNDP temporary jetty is delayed due to bad weather and heavy swells. It will be operational and open for public at the end of September at the earliest.

The m/v "Bunga Sejati" will be re-delivered to owners due to no availability of cargo. WFPSS will continue to operate four LCTs.

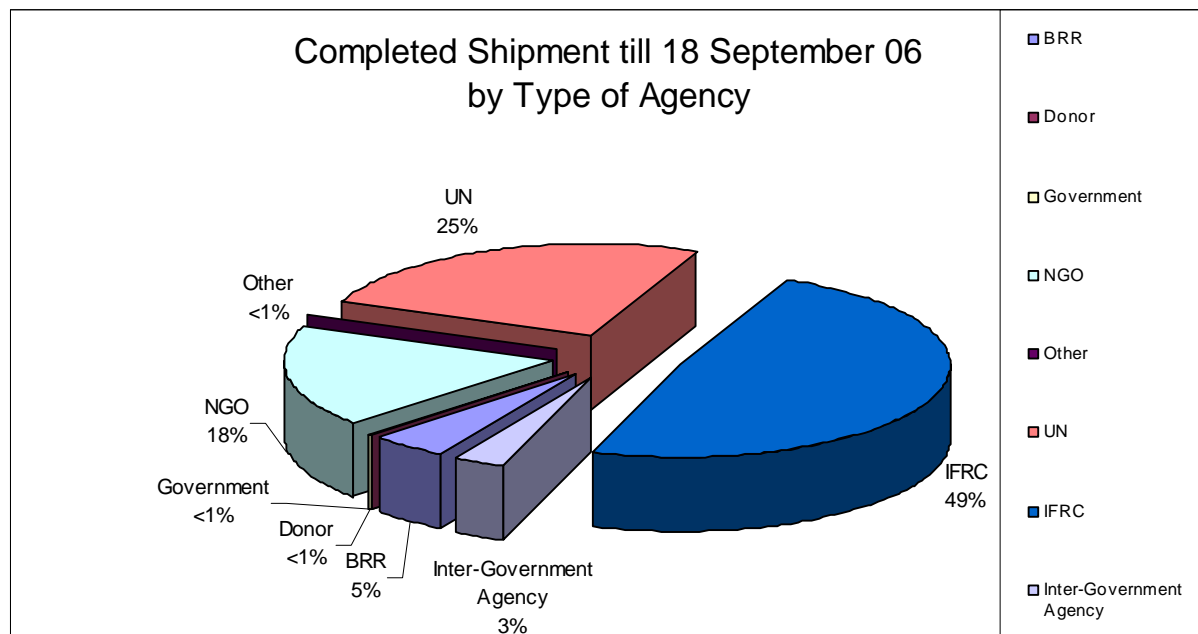
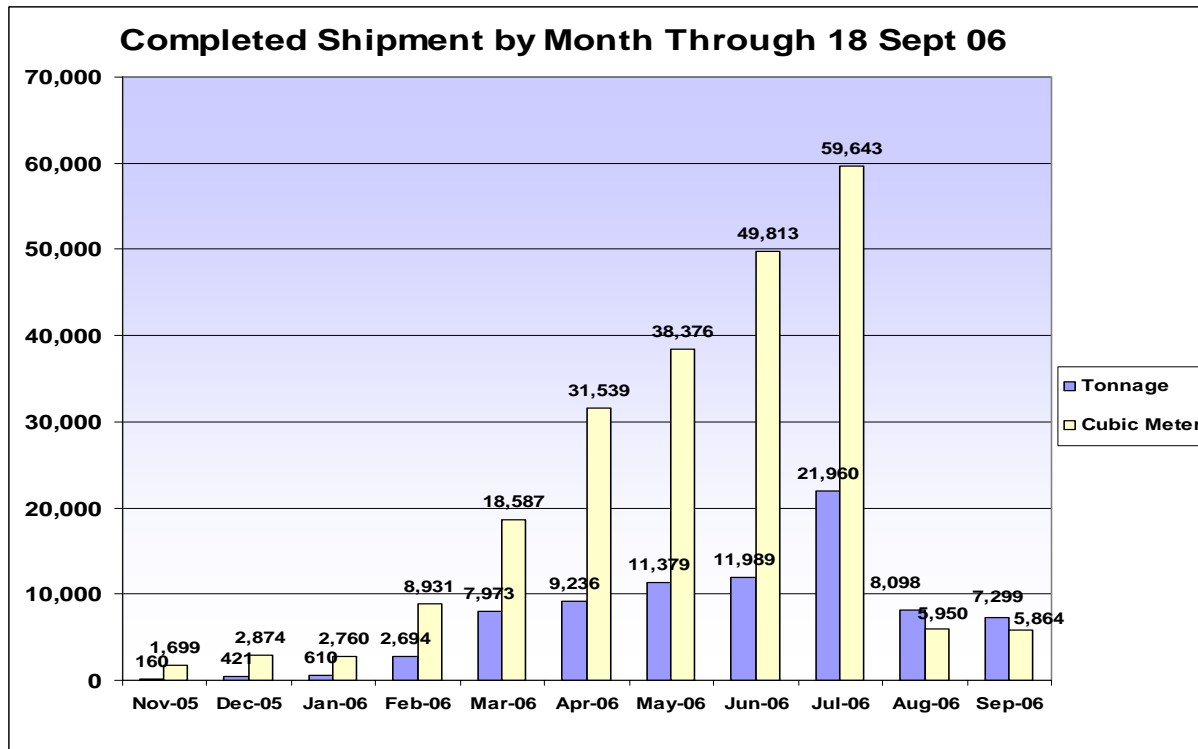
Tariff - Time Charter
