## Cancellation of building Jetty at Naserheu in Salang District, Simuelue

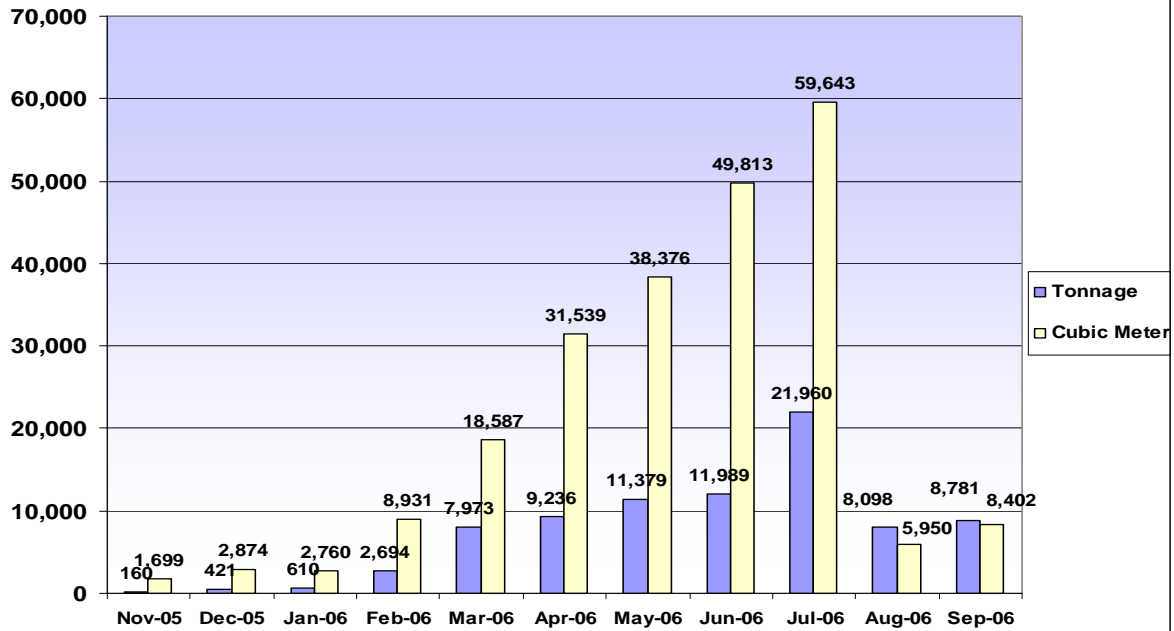

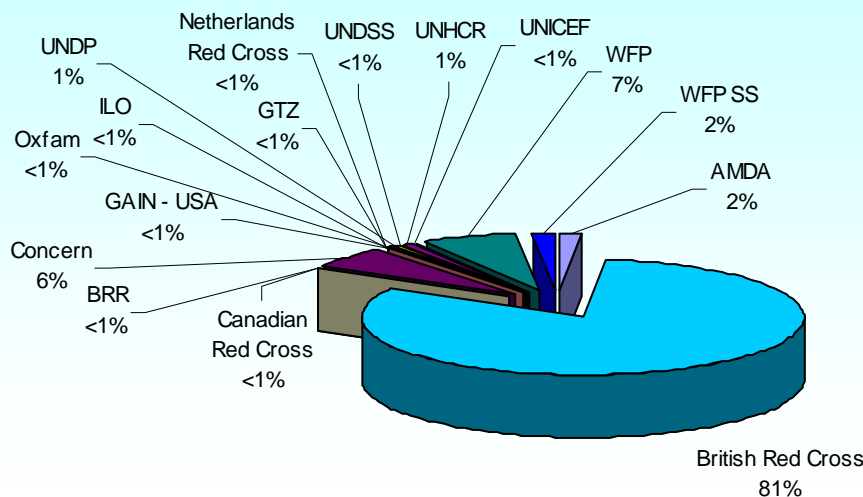
