Hopefully the forklift can be utilized for that operation. Forklifts are being secured by CARE with 24 hour guards.

Labitra Nakita arrived in the Rigaih Jetty on 17 October, at 11:45 hrs with 220 t of WFP food items and one Manitou forklift on board. Discharging activities completed on 18 October at 15:30 hrs. Nakita sailed out ex Calang on 18 October at 16:00 hrs and ETA Ulee Lheue is 19 October at 10:00 hrs.

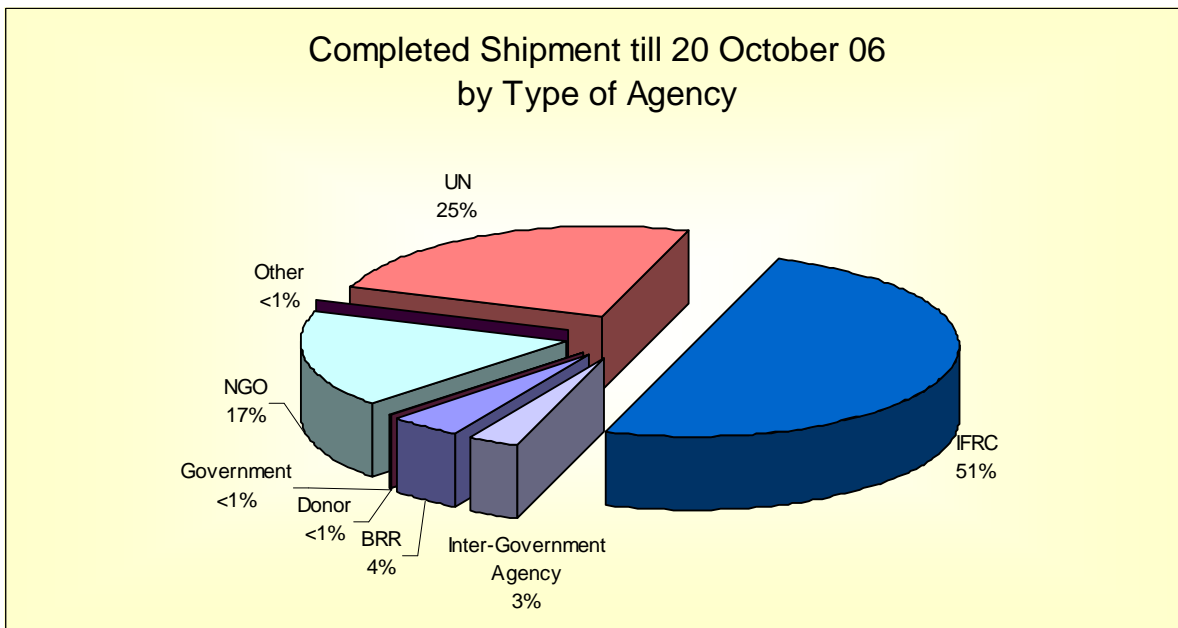
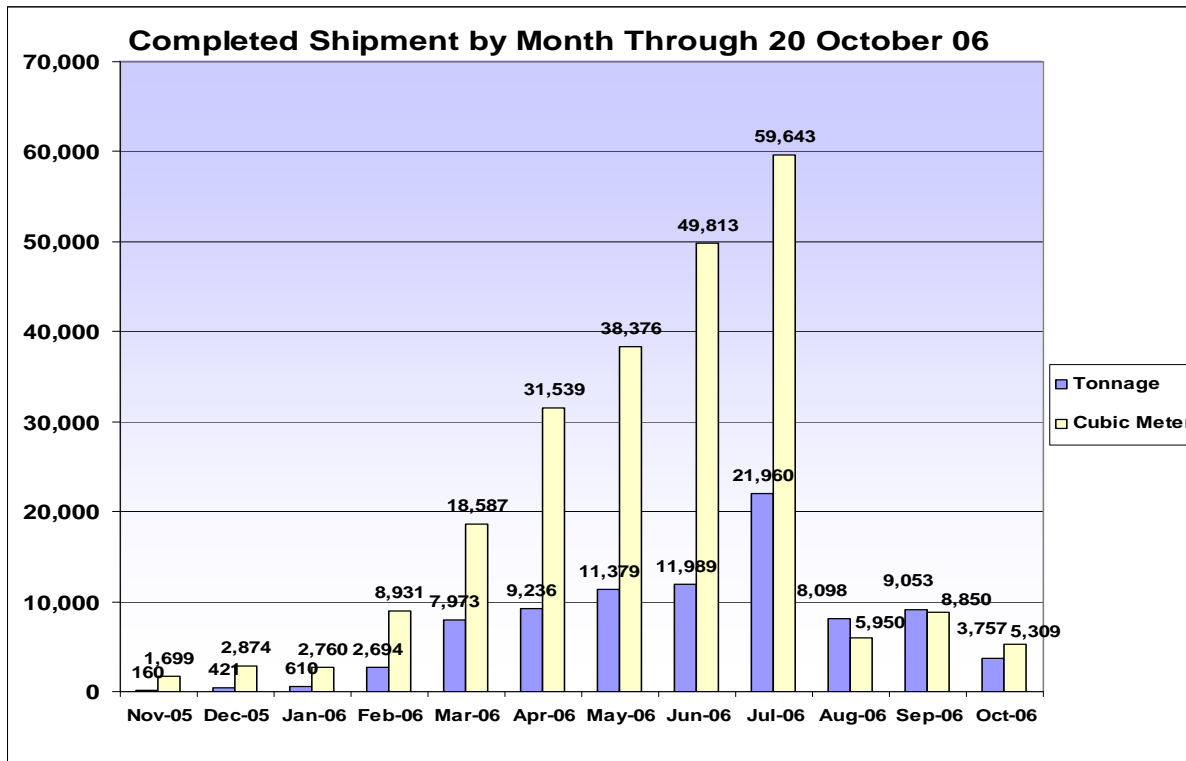
