## Banda Aceh

After completing 756 MT British Red Cross cargo to Pulo Aceh with Labitra Adinda on Friday AM (24 Nov. 06) at Ulee Lheue, Banda Aceh is preparing to load more than 700 MT Zero To One Foundation construction material for the same destination. Oxfam also have approximately 700 MT construction material that needs to be transported to 3 different villages at Pulo Aceh (Lamteng, Pasi

Janeng and Raboo village). Cargo details have been provided and cargos are being palletised, estimated ready date 10 December. WFP Shipping Service will survey proposed landing sites and report back to Oxfam.

WFP mission from Rome ( Mr. Ramiro Lopes Da Silva - Director of Transport and Procurement and Mr. Didier Frisch - Chief of ODTS together with Jens baekholm - Head of WFP Shipping Service, Peter French - Technical Advisor WFP Shipping Service, John Brady & Pak Egan - BRR) paid a visit to Nias for on 21 & 22 November 2006 to look at our operation and visit port sites as well as advising WFP Shipping Service user about future plans and face down of WFP Shipping Service Mr. Ronald - Agricultural Advisor form HALCROW Intl., UNDP partner, paid a second visit to Nias office on Thursday (22 Nov. 2006) morning to follow up on the tariffs and possibility of locating/providing them with storage facilities once decision is taken with regard to 1200 MT of fertilizer and 150 mini tractors shipment in the year 2007.

Labitra Hanny sailed noon time on WED 23rd.Nov .2006 to Lahusa and Tagaule carrying 163.470 M<sup>3</sup> cargo for NRC and 359.24 M<sup>3</sup> for AMDA. Port Captain together with 2 Logistic Assistants are on mission to Lahusa and Tagaule to supervise the cargo off-loading for NRC and AMDA. WFP PRRO have asked to ship 200 MT food items from Nias to Simeuleu

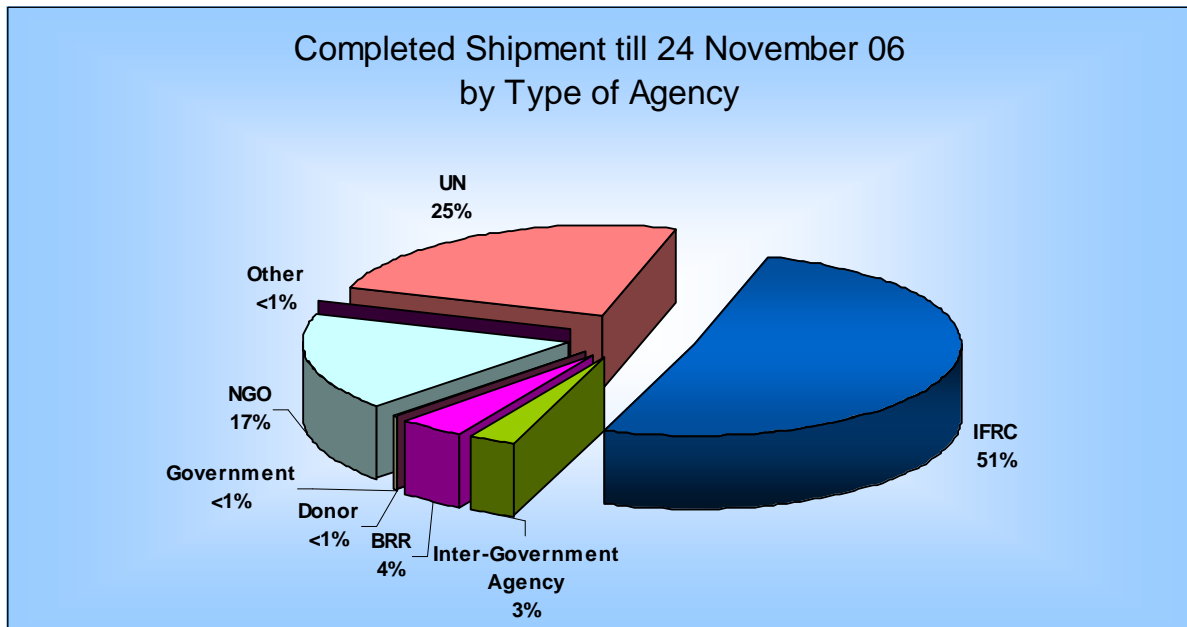
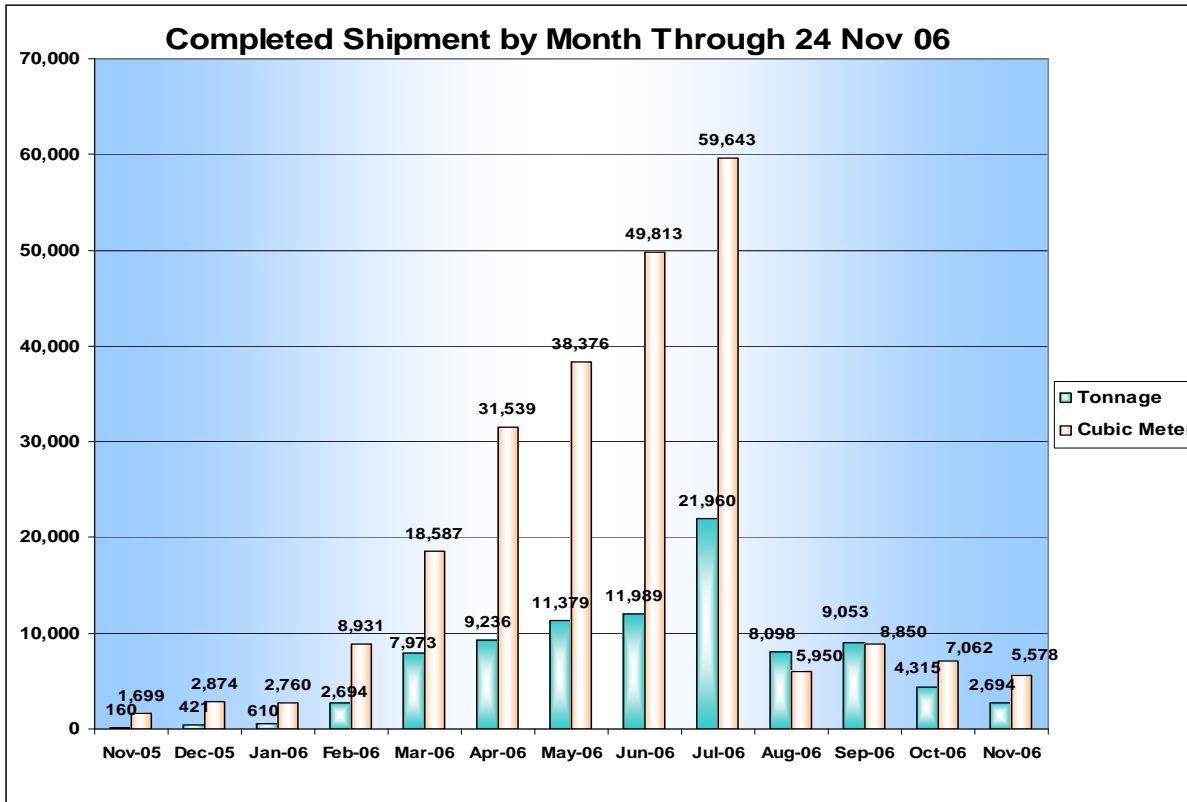
