**The Operation**

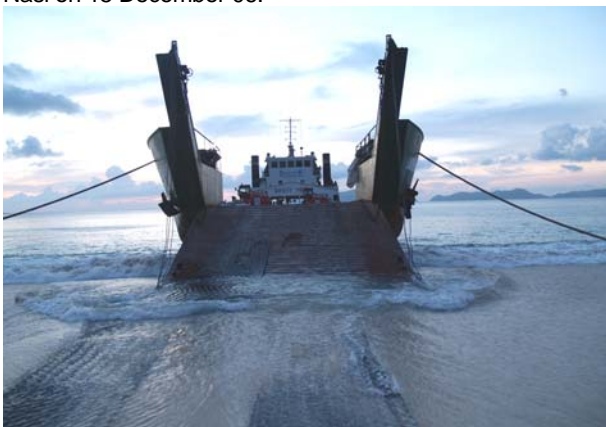

**Nias**

A joint UNORC / WFPSS meeting was convened with Mr. Jeremy Brown- Senior Transport Economist Consultant and Mohammed Siddik –consultant from MEYRICK and Associates representing the World Bank and MDF .

Mr. Brown project is for the World Bank and his overall focus is on transport and special focus on sea shipment sites. He added that he will be looking at all constraints and developing recommendations to allow Shipping Service to sustain and how to attract a commercial operator. He also added, it is obvious at this moment that BRR are not clear on what their volume projections are. An overview on WFPSS Nias operation was highlighted by Logistic Officer Ibrahim. It was noted that some commercial operators might not be interested in all area and may focus on special routes. This will be looked at during his assessment. Mr. Brown will be meeting IOM, CRC, NRC, SRC. A joint visit with WFPSS took place to old and new port sites

**Multiple Road Blocks along the West Coast**

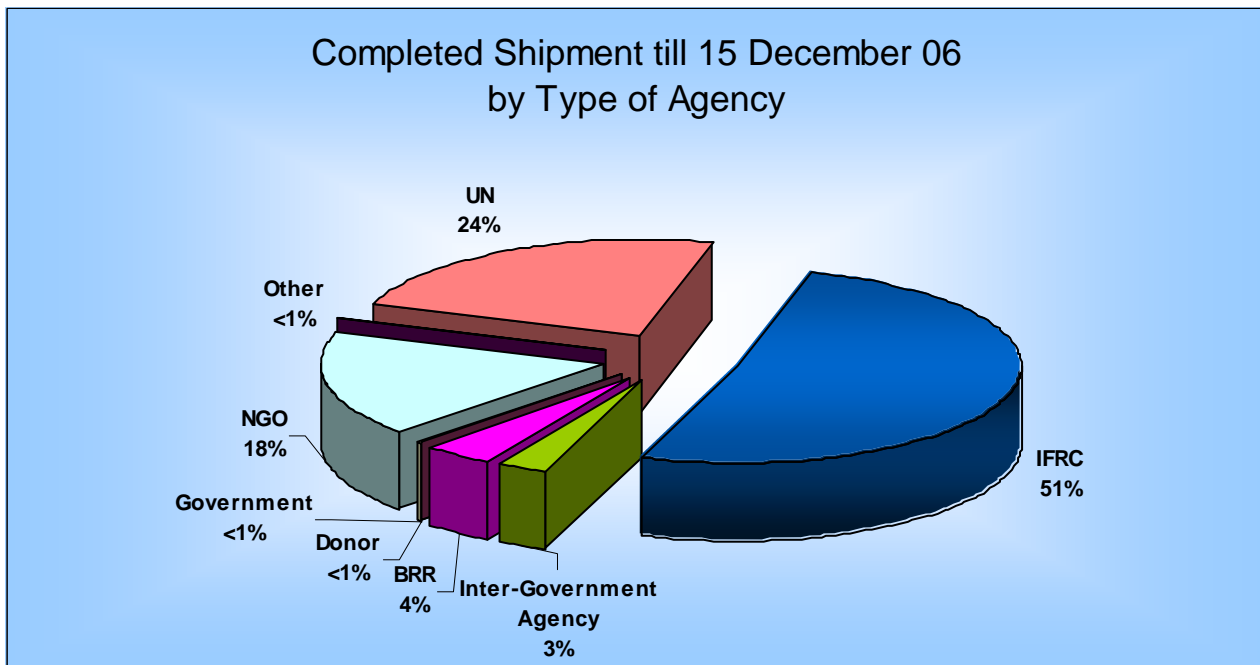
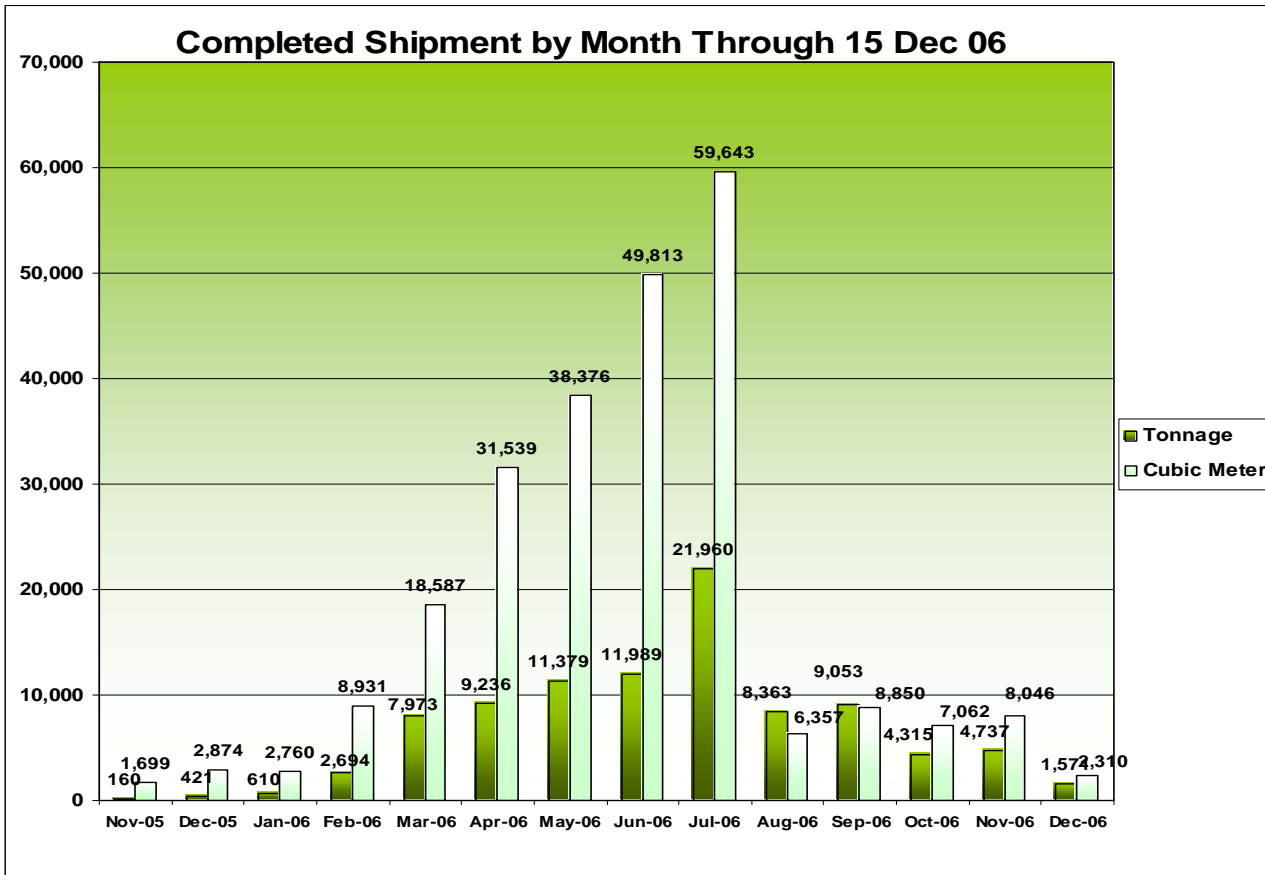
