The Operation

Niaga Jaya 12: After completing discharge at Sinabang, Niaga Jaya 12 was redelivered to her owner on Wednesday, 3 January 2007, 12:00. **Labitra Nakita:** After completing discharge in Gn. Sitoli, Nias, Labitra Nakita was redelivered to her owner in Tanjung Priok, Jakarta on Sunday, 7 January 2007. **Labitra Hanny:** Sailed from Sinabang on 4th January for Malahayati with biscuits and noodles for WFP that will be distributed to the flood victims. She will load out of Malahayati for Simuelue on 8 January 2007.

Transition Plan to Commercial Operators

Operation: WFPSS is currently operating one LCT - Labitra Hanny, after redelivery of two other vessels - Niaga Jaya 12 and Labitra Nakita to their owners. The Shipping Service will continue to provide logistics support by assisting users with cargo consolidation, and giving technical advice through their Port Captains and Logistics Officers on how to package and transport cargo in the most cost-effective fashion.

Staff: As part of the transition plan, three international staff left at the end of 2006 on the completion of their missions, and two senior national staff have been recruited. Captain Syariful A Lubis, joined WFPSS in the capacity of Port Captain on 3 January 07. He will undergo a three week induction that will incorporate visits to all ports and operations, thereafter he will be based in Banda Aceh. Doddy Kusharyono, joined WFPSS as a National Shipping Officer as of 8 January 07. He has worked for WFPSS as Shipping Assistant since 1 January 2006.

Banda Aceh

Banda Aceh office discharged Labitra Hanny at Malahayati port and will load WFP cargo to Simeulue.

Manitou all terrain forklifts with our trained drivers, have been used on a number of occasions, supporting LCT Labitra Adinda (operated under a commercial operator - Haritos) for loading and discharge operations of ZTOF traffic out of Ulee Lhee and the discharge at Pulo Aceh.

Nias

Labitra Nakita discharged cargo at Lahusa and Bodzihona, in Nias, returned to Gunung Sitoli for bunker, and then sailed for Tanjung Priok for redelivery to her owner on 7 January 2007.

The WFPSS Port Captain based in Nias, will undertake a number of port studies incorporating Lahewa and Afulu and possible landing sites at Sirombo.

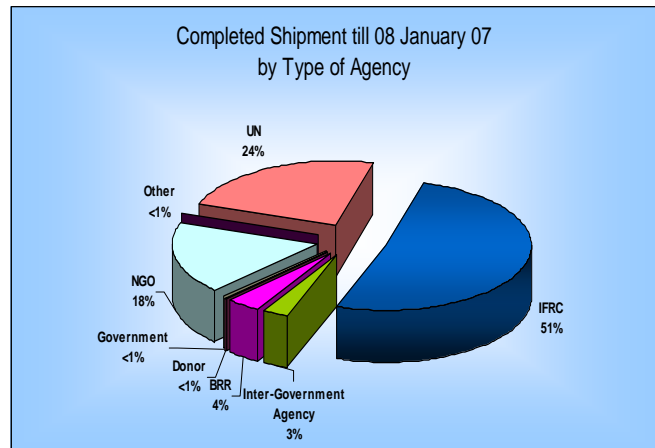
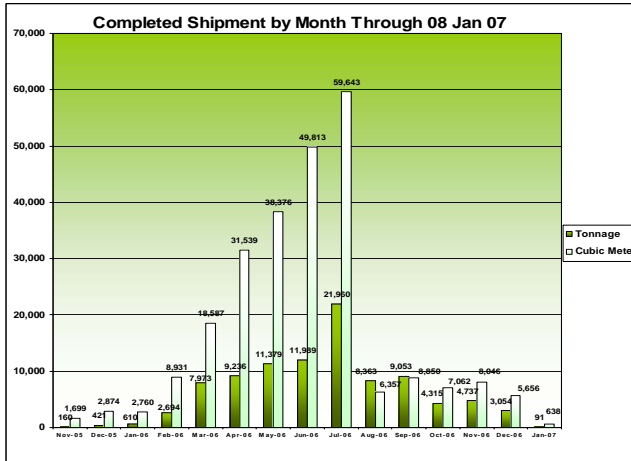
Simeulue

Daily Express 1 (operated by a Commercial Operator – Limin Marine) arrived at Sinabang at 1230 hrs on the 28th of December 2006 with 432.22 MT of cargo. The entire discharge activity was supervised by a Port Captain and a Logistic Assistant from WFPSS. The cargo was discharged by 2 WFPSS Forklift manitou and 3 drivers as per request submitted by the vessel owner.

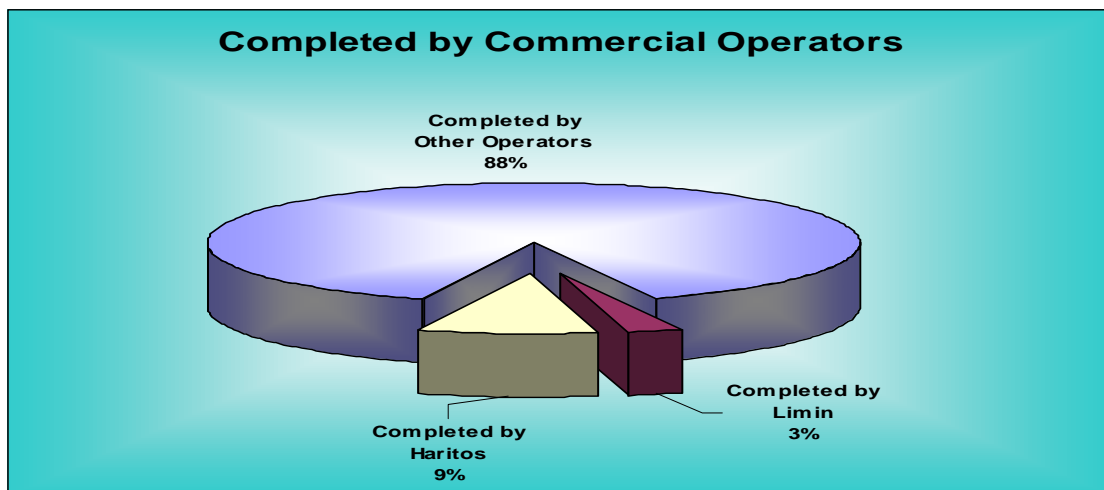


Daily express discharge cargo at Sinabang, the vessel owner rent WFPSS manitou to assist discharge activity
