Belawan

WFPSS Belawan completed loading Labitra Hanny on Thursday 25 January 2007 afternoon. More than 400 M³ loaded, some of the cargo will be unloaded at Sinabang (CONCERN cargo) and the rest will be discharged at Lahusa (NRC cargo). Labitra Hanny will stop by at Ulee Lheu to load more cargo from Care International to Sinabang.

Gunung Sitoli (Nias Island)

The newly recruited National Port Captain and the National Shipping Officer from Banda Aceh office had paid a 4 day visit to Nias to get the new port captain familiarized with Nias operation.

UNORC, BRR and HELP office were also visited on 24th and 25th January 07 where details of future cargo projection from all users were requested.

The National Port Captain and the National Shipping Officer together with WFPSS Nias staff attended the BRR Nias logistics meeting on 25 January 07 and briefed all participants of WFPSS present status. WFPSS is downsizing but the service will continue until such a time it can be handed over to commercial venue. Commercialization process is continuing with success and WFPSS will render our assistance to bridge the gap to commercial operators. WFPSS presently have one vessel in service until further notice and still render services with regard to equipment, logistic support and contact to ship-owners.

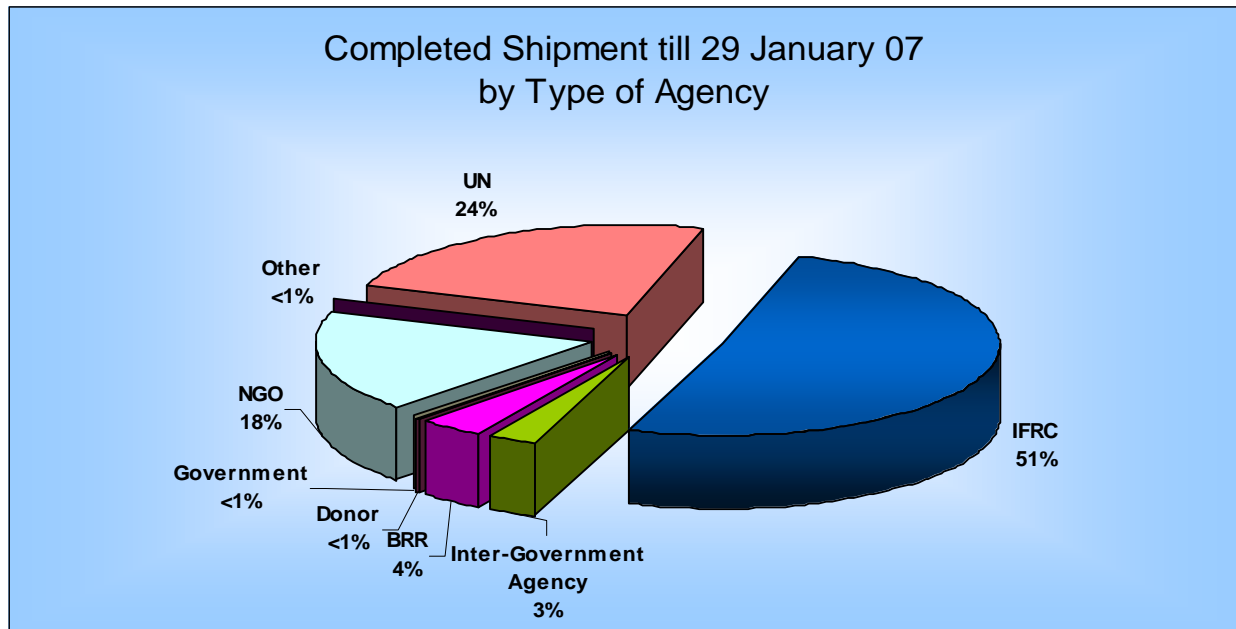
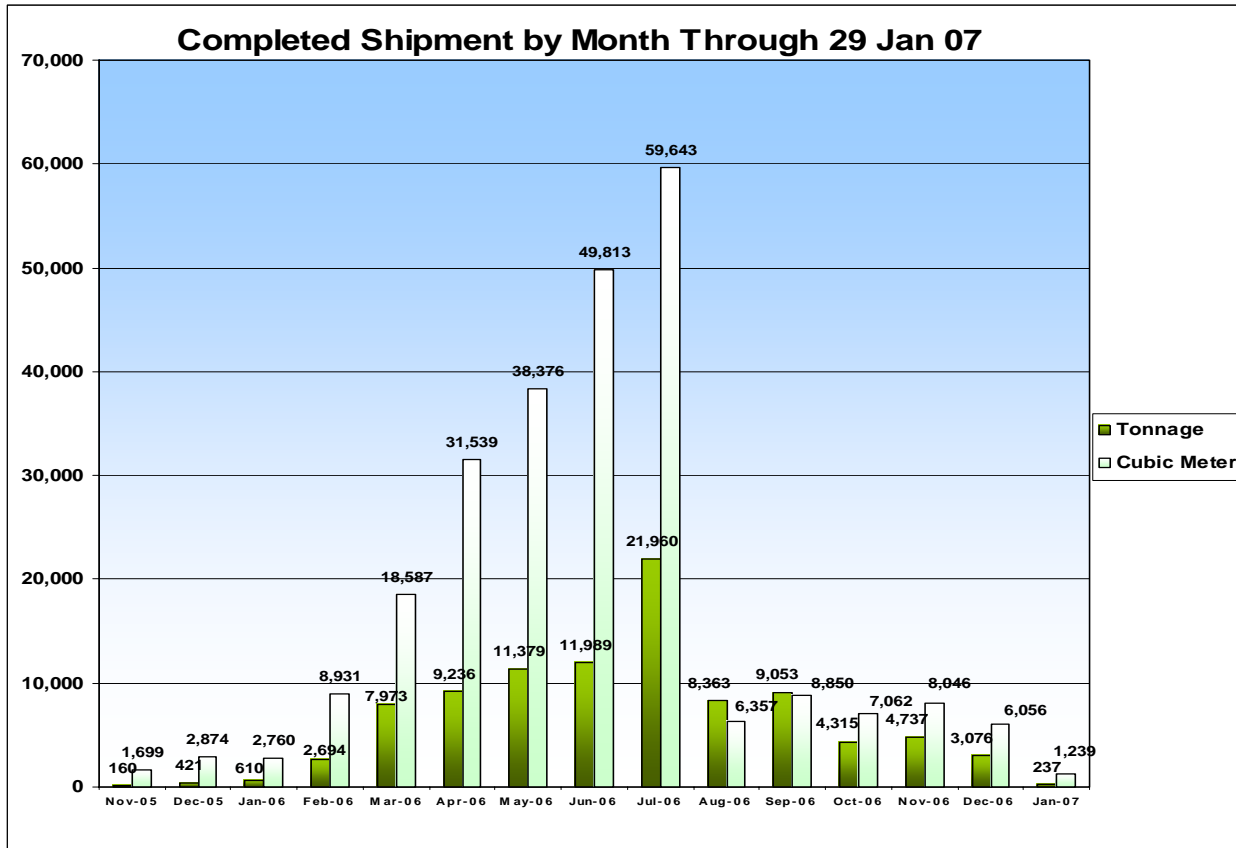
Projects and Missions in Nias

A joint mission to Lahewa took place on 23rd of January to survey Lahewa port for the Canadian Red Cross (CRC) and to meet Mr. Donald G. Bourne, the Logistics Coordinator. CRC is planning to build 2100 houses = 6000 tons of cargo, where cargo expected to arrive in the coming months between March and April 2007.

HELP has initially 300 M³ of timber in the pipeline and since 3,000 M³ of timber in international bidding; NRC still has 300 M³ of cargo per month.

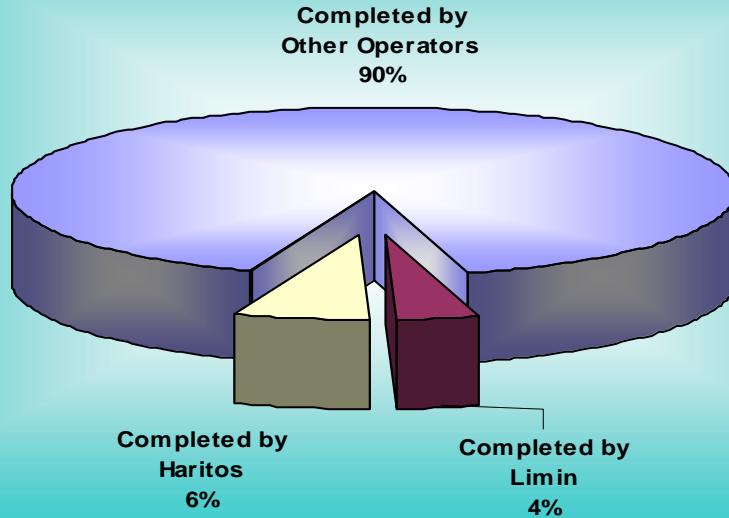
BRR reported that the Southern half part of the deck at Gunung Sitoli port was completed and work is in progress for the Northern part. Expected time of completion is end of April as advised by BRR Technical Advisor where port is operating at reduced capacity for another two months. It is estimated that a total of 120,000 MT of materials is required for 2007 for housing construction, out of this timber is estimated to be 45,000 MT. So far no timber has been seen arriving to the island except Cement in a reasonable adequate quantity excluding other infrastructure materials like schools, health centres and other public building. i.e. 10,000 MT /month which are still remain high. This will result in shortage of timber in year 2007.

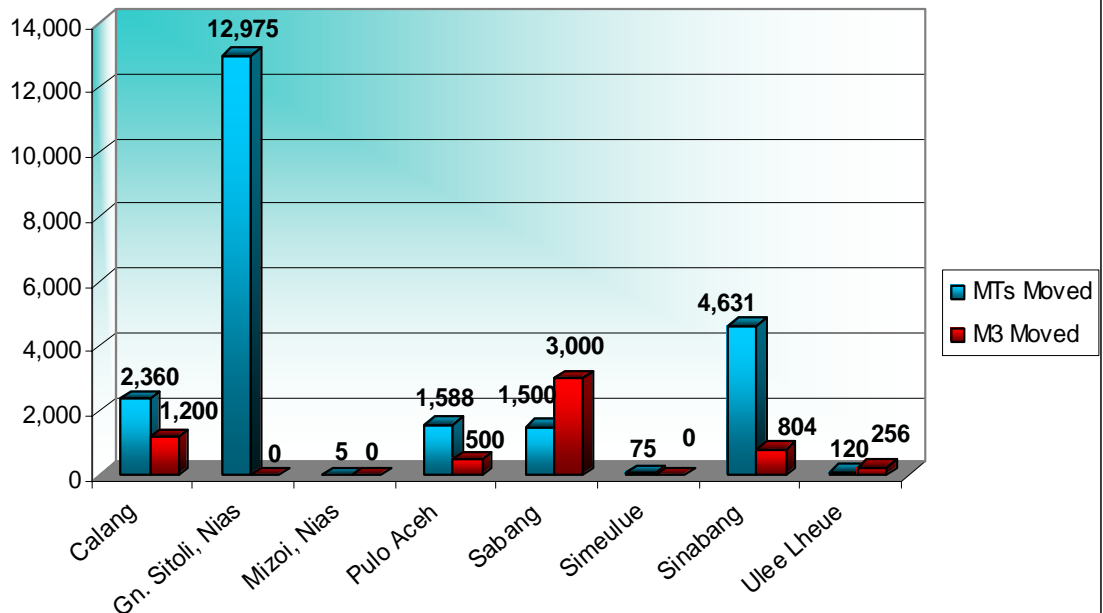
