Banda Aceh

15 February 2007 - WFPSS Banda Aceh Logistics team supervised Labitra Hanny to discharge four containers and some concrete blocks for American Red Cross at Pulo Aceh. Two WFPSS Manitou forklifts were used to load and unload the containers from and to the vessel.

Banuagea, Nias

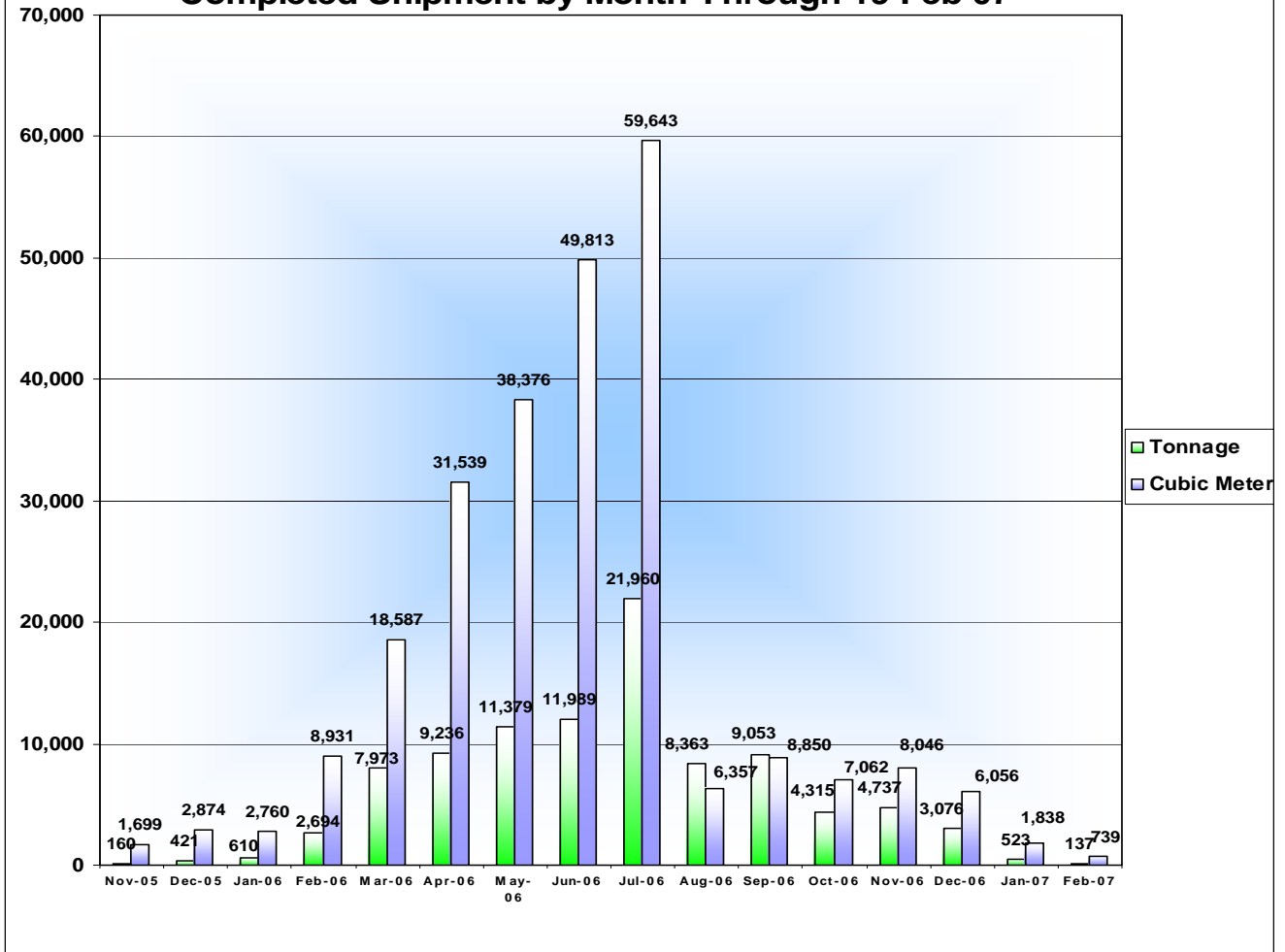
15 February 2007— a ground breaking ceremony was held by Asian Development Bank (ADB) and UN-HABITAT in Banuagea, North Nias to mark the starting of construction of 486 new houses.

ADB through UN-HABITAT's Nias Settlements Support Program (NSSP) is providing support for the construction of 486 unit houses in four villages in North Nias, Banuagea, Sawo, Hiliduruwa and Silimabanua.

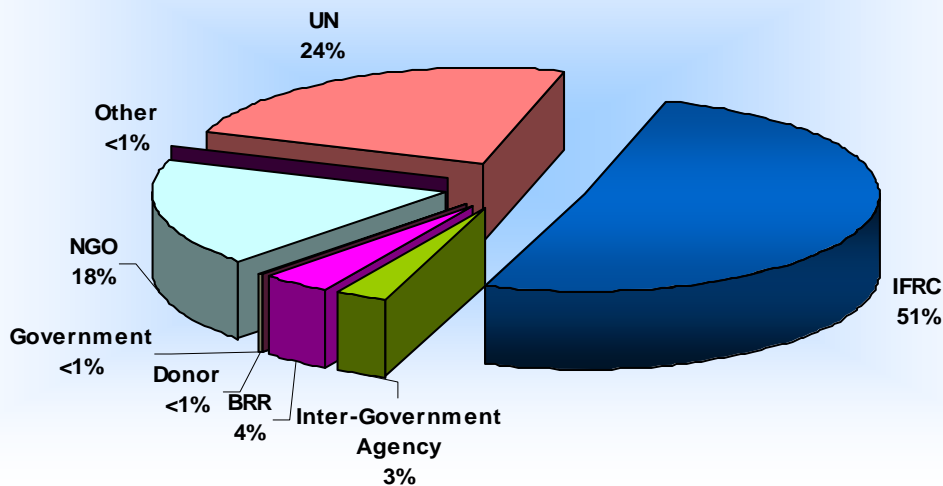
Reconstruction of the houses including basic infrastructure such as drainage, septic tank, village road and water supply will take an estimated five months to complete. The project will cost an estimated US\$ 4.3 million. UN-HABITAT/ADB project will also provide assistance to construct a piped water supply system to serve all 1,700 households in these four villages at the cost of US\$ 537,000.

Completed Shipment by Month Through 19 Feb 07

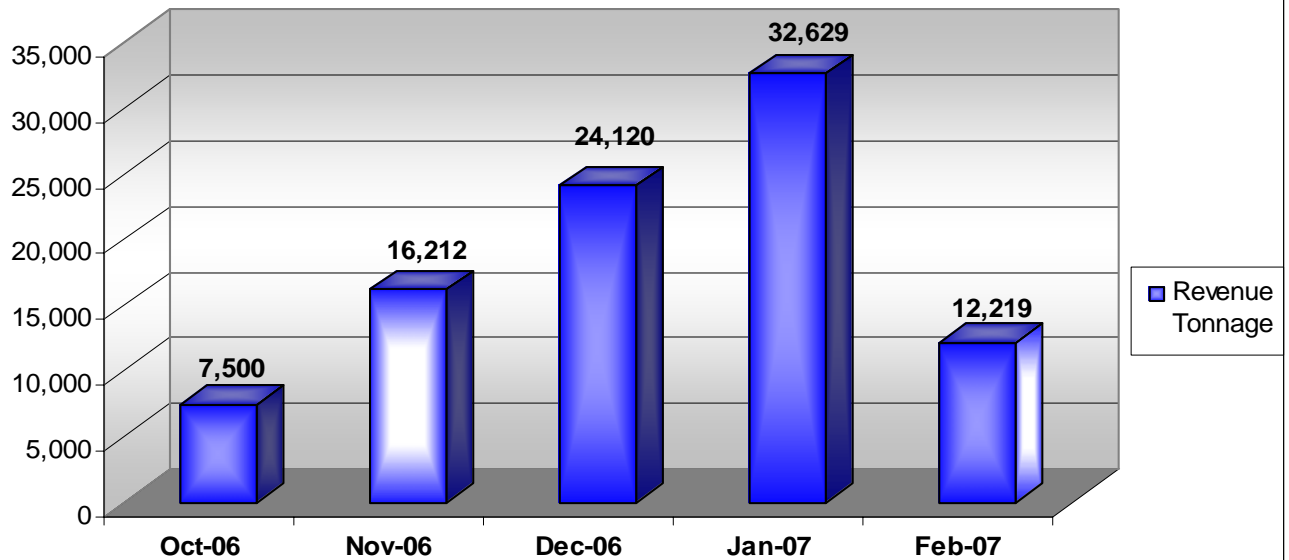


Completed Shipment till 19 February 07 by Type of Agency

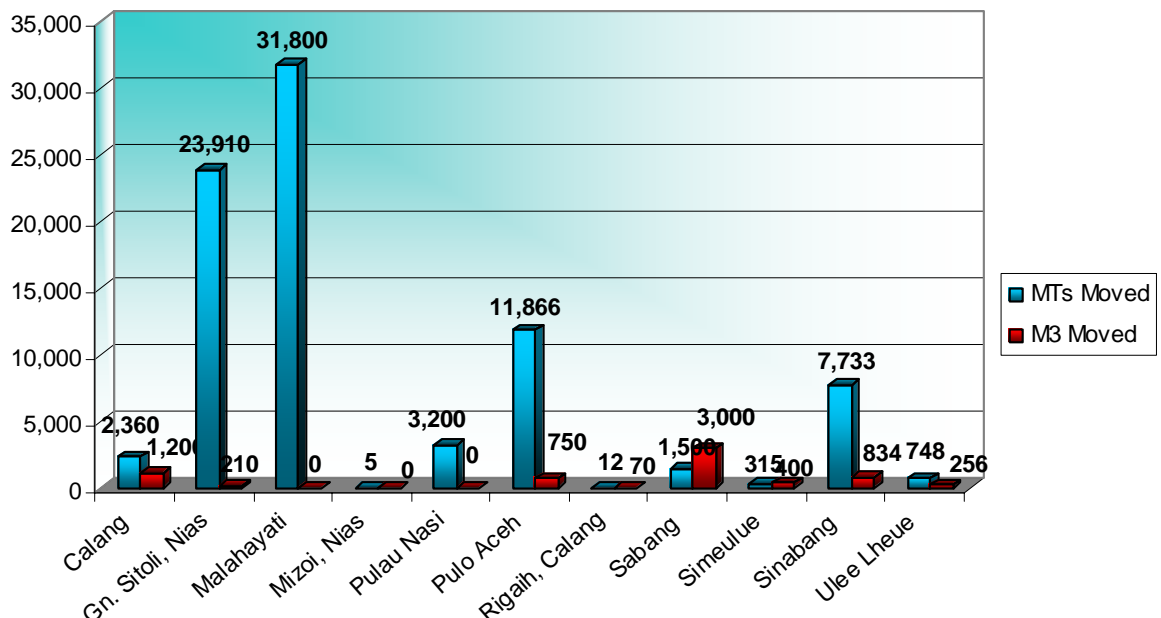
