WFPSS management has made a decision to redeliver Labitra Hanny to her owner in Tegal, West Java on or about the 9th March 2007.

Although WFPSS will not have any vessel in operation, WFPSS will continue to provide the logistic support by assisting users with cargo consolidation, giving technical advice through their port captain and logistic officer on how to package and transport cargo in the most cost-effective fashion. In addition, WFPSS will continue renting the forklifts to facilitate the loading and discharging process and do surveys at proposed landing sites.

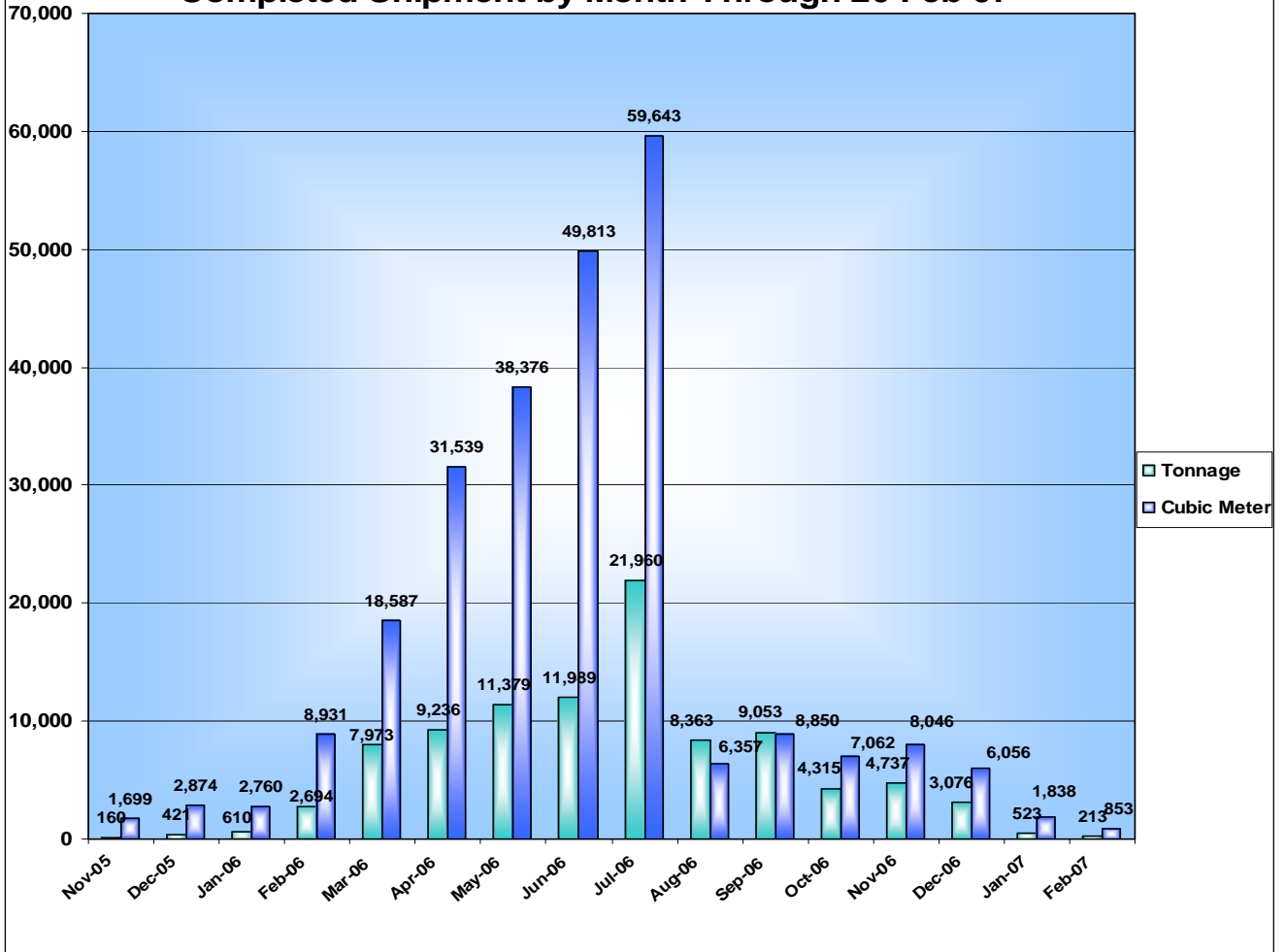
WFPSS Manitou Forklift assisting cargo discharging activity at Sinabang Port

Cargo delivered by Commercial Operators

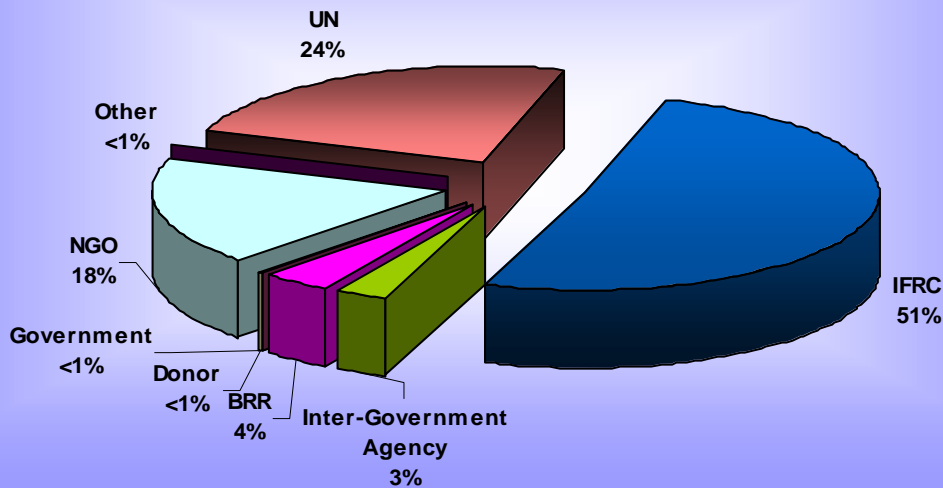

Completed Shipment by Month Through 26 Feb 07

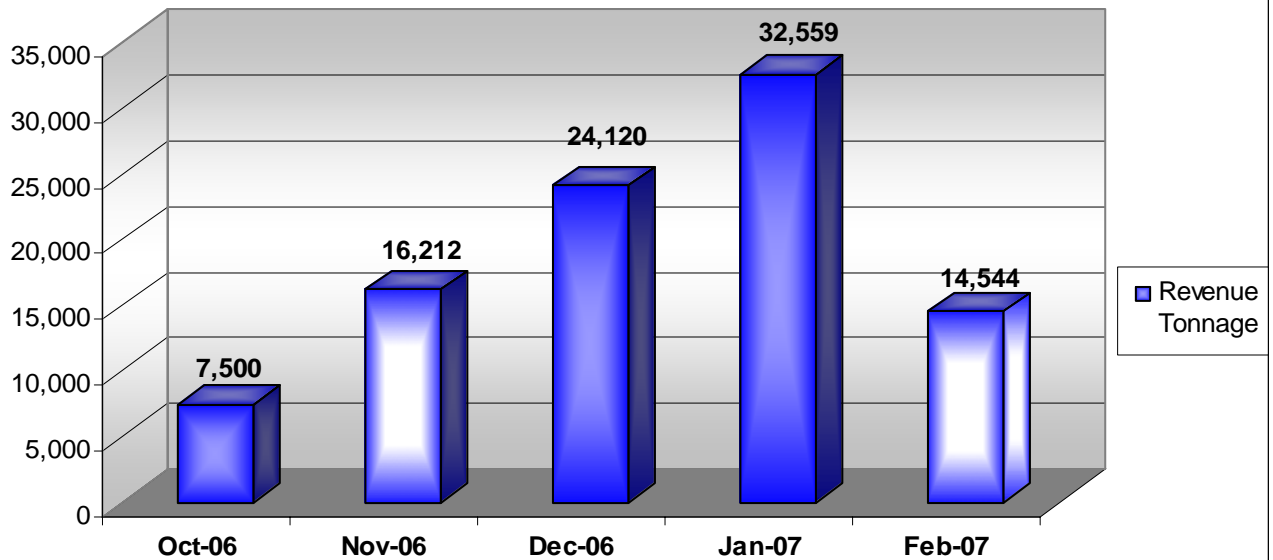


Completed Shipment till 26 February 07 by Type of Agency

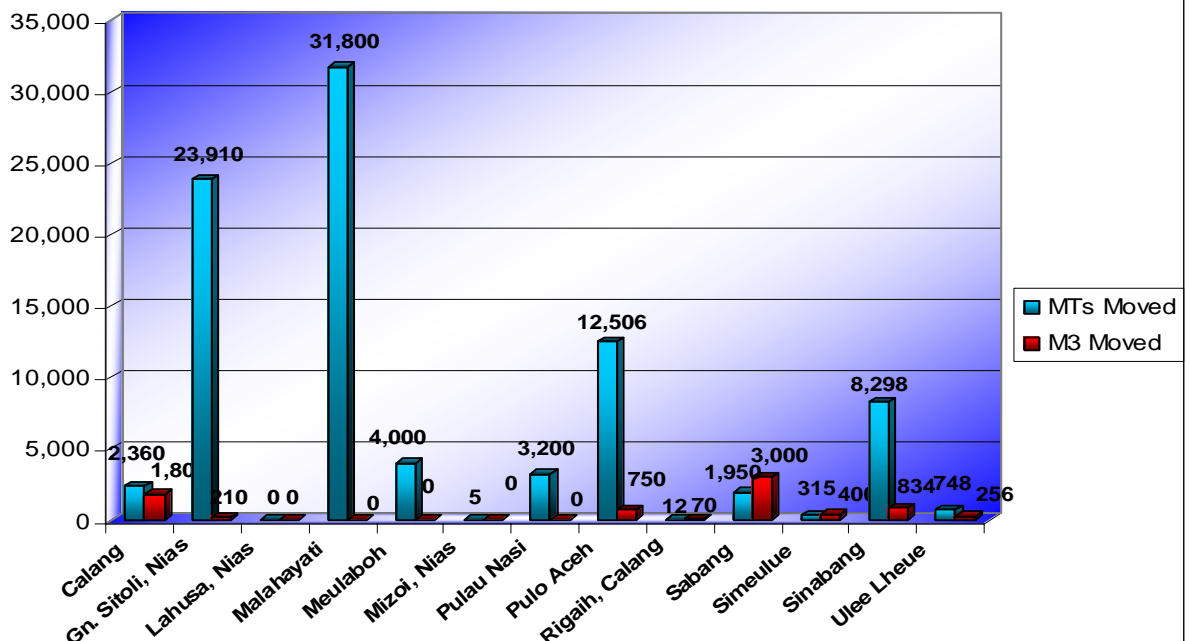
