Landing Site Survey

At the request of IFRC and the Vessel operators, WFPSS Port Captain and Senior Logistics Assistant, accompanied by IFRC representatives, conducted landing site surveys at Nasrehue on the 8th of June and Patriot on the following day.

Nasrehue is located inside the Ug Matabano point, facing the Lingam Island on the west coast of Simeulue. The landing site was built by the Japanese Red Cross and is still being used by them. The site is clear and approaches are navigable.



Patriot is located inside the bay of Teluk Lugu Sibigo. The road and bridges from Sinabang through to Patriot are in an inferior state of repair.

The approaches to the proposed landing Patriot site are navigable, there are a number of actions that will have to be undertaken prior to the discharge operations: 1) Establish mooring points on the beach for securing of the landing craft. 2) Compress the earth to allow easy movement for the cargo handling equipment in the proposed off take area from end of ramp and storage areas. 3) Compact and even out the bank of the landing site to allow the safe positioning of the vessels ramp door.

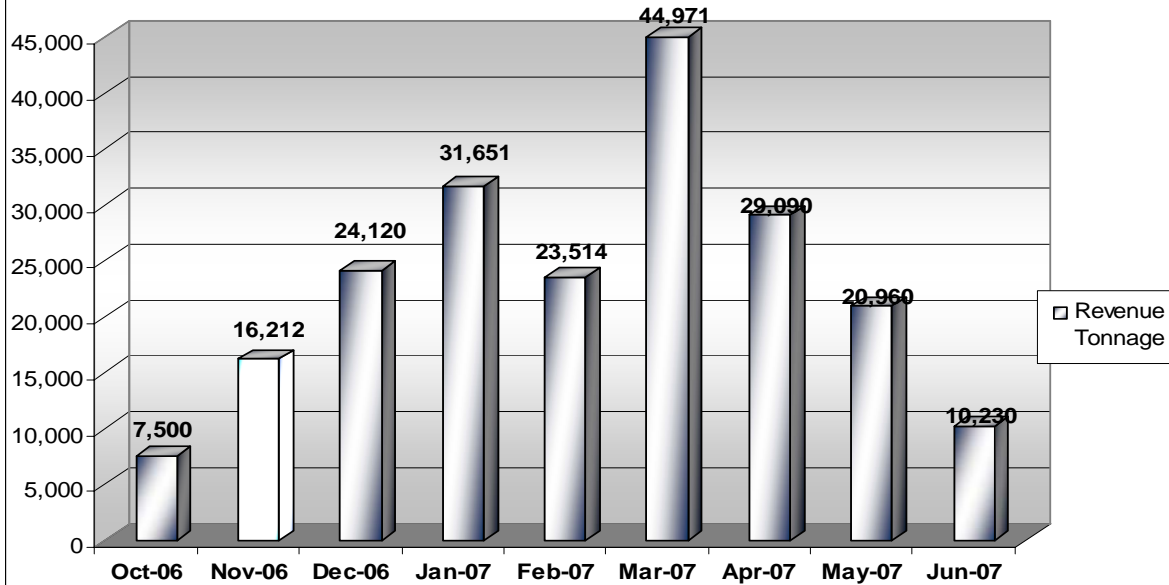

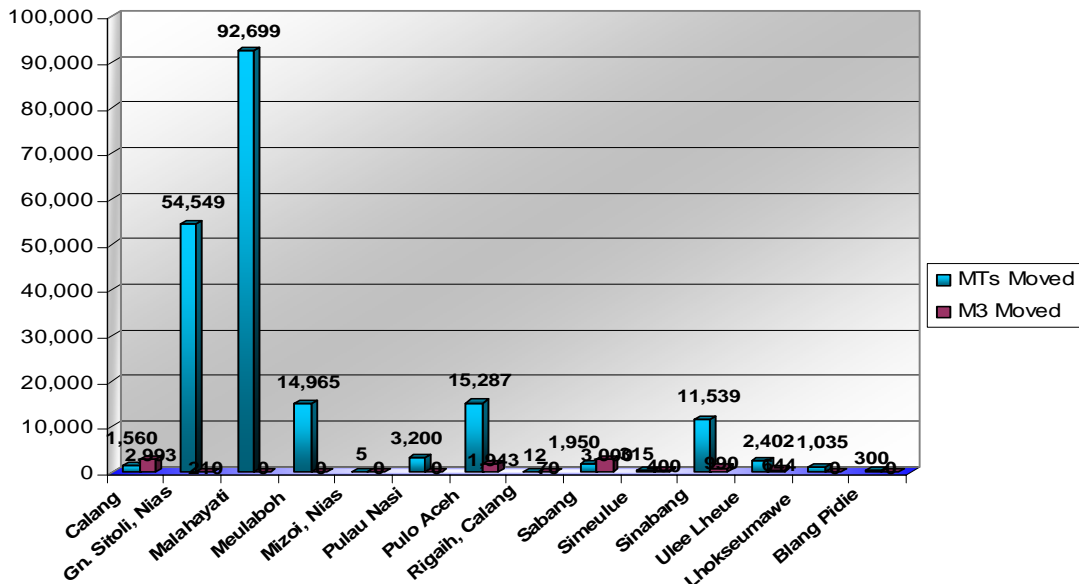
