**Banda Aceh**

WFPSS assisted ATLAS Logistique to unload containers from road truck to the warehouse; two units Manitou Forklift were utilized for this operation.

**Belawan**

WFPSS Belawan has assisted IFRC and the carriers stevedores in pre planning and loading the LCT SUMBER POWER to Patriot.



In addition WFPSS has two Reach Stackers in Belawan now available for rental on an hourly basis.

**Simeulue**

Sumber Carrier II, completed discharge of IFRC cargos at Nesreheu, two Manitou operators were positioned from Sinabang for the cargo operations. Seven and half hours were required to complete the discharge. This is last shipment to Nasrehue and upon completion of the operation; both Manitous will be returned to Ulee Lhue. IFRC have four shipments consigned to Patriot.



**Nias**

The Logistics Workshop arranged by BRR on 12 July 2007, WFP SS / LSU Nias presented two scenarios, (1) WFPSS transition to LSU and (2) current situation in Nias (Gunung Sitoli) and Nias Selatan (Teluk Dalam). BRR Nias willing to increase our function to support logistics access to remote areas.

The Manager of Multi Donor Funds, Christian Rey visited Nias, on 13 July 2007 to monitor the progress of projects funded by MDF.

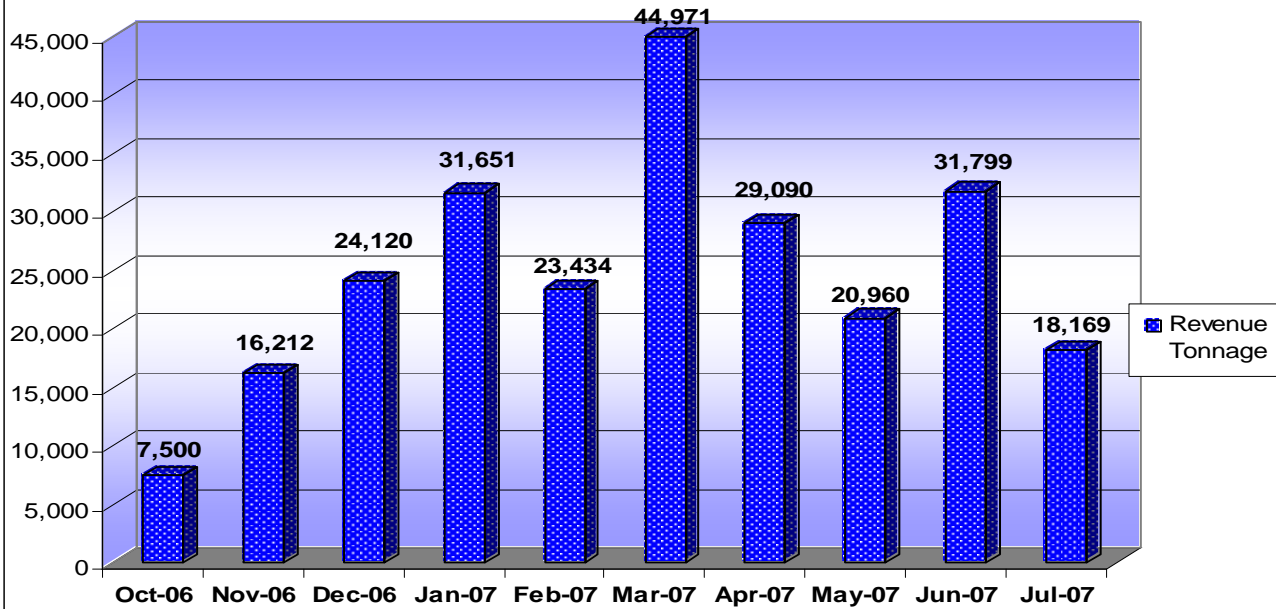

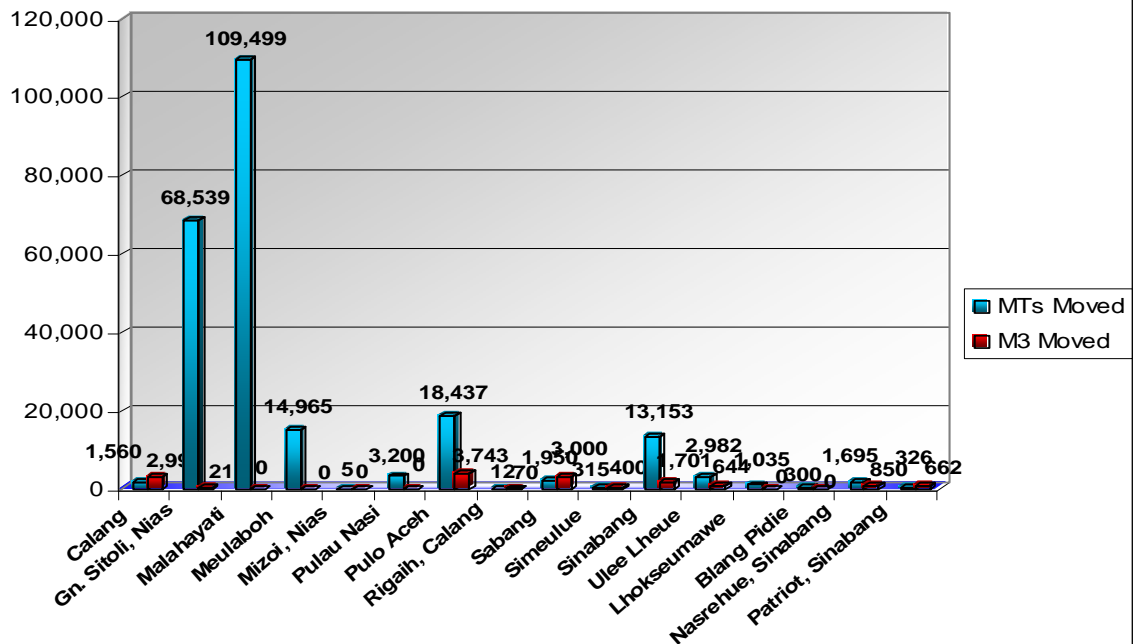
