ITEM 1: ADOPTION OF MINUTES OF SEA USERS' GROUP (SUG) MEETING HELD ON 24 MARCH 06

1. Peter French chaired the meeting for this week. There was no comment on the Minutes of the last meeting and they were adopted.

ITEM 2: TARRIFS

2. A Spreadsheet with Cost (USD) per MT based on daily cost of operations for LCT was distributed among attendants. The listed cost will be very close to the actual

one that will be applied. However, WFP Shipping Service will give one month notice for all users before the cost is applied.

ITEM 3: WFP FOOD

3. WFP will be free of charge for using vessel's service, subject to final confirmation by WFP.

ITEM 4: REPORT ON THE VESSELS CURRENTLY ON CHARTER

4. There are 6 LCTs which currently on charter. 3 LCTs; Pacific Spirit, Sumber Power and Daily Express 1 are running on Belawan route. One LCT is serving Sibolga – Nias.

ITEM 5: REVIEW OF COMPLETED SHIPMENTS

5. The complete shipment was presented in a spreadsheet and distributed to all attendants (file attached). It is shown in the graphic bar that the total cargo moved in the month of March has exceeded twice the number in February, either in metric ton or square meter.

ITEM 6: PLANNED SHIPMENTS FOR WEEK 13

6. Planned Shipment for the coming weeks:

- LCT Son Bak 202 will carry IOM trucks from Ulee Lheue to Nias.

ITEM 7: ANY OTHER BUSINESS

7. Atlas Logistique asked for the possibility of WFP Shipping Service to handle container cargo from Medan or Jakarta which will be shipped to Aceh. WFP Shipping Service could handle the container cargo from Belawan on limited basis by destuffing the containers.

8. Atlas Logistique is handling the shipment to destinations such as Pulo Aceh and Sabang for NGOs who concern more on the frequency of shipment instead of quantity. For big cargo Atlas Logistique will asked the NGO to use WFP Shipping Services'. In Banda Aceh Atlas Logistique operates:

- 2 x 20T boats and 1 x 60T boat in Banda Aceh
- 2 boats in Simeulue.
- 10 Trucks in Banda Aceh
- 16 Trucks in Calang
- 10 Vehicles in Meulaboh

9. UNOPS is expecting to have more cargoes to be shipped in the couple of months
