4. There are currently eight vessels on charter. One of them, Prima Samudra is chartered to carry timber from Kalimantan Island to Gunung Sitoli, as well as for other cargo which maybe available. LCT Labitra Hanny has to undergo some repair and its operation is replaced by LCT Laut Mas.
